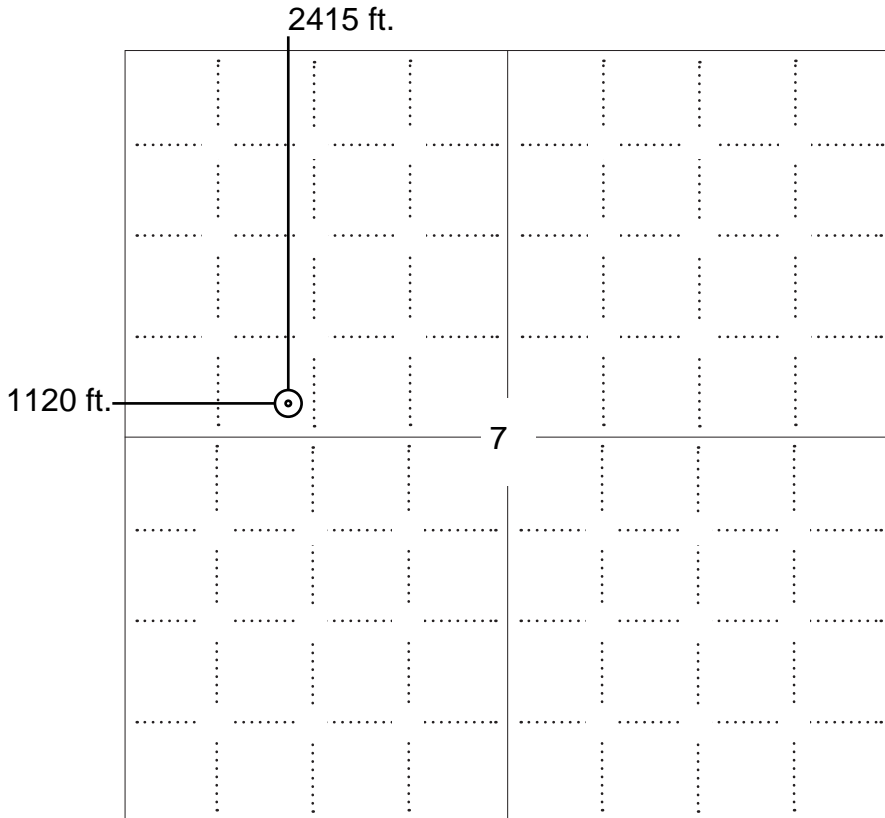

Oil and Gas Lease 1633

AGREEMENT Made and entered into the 8th day of June A. D. 1924, by and between P.A. Hull and Emma Hull wife of P.A. Hull, Howard C. Higgins and C. C. Higgins, all of Ellipton, Kansas, parties of the first part, lessors, and E. J. Sobel of Tulsa, Oklahoma, party of second part, lessees,

WITNESSETH, That the said party... of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar to... in hand well and truly paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and of the covenants and agreements hereinafter contained on the part of the party of the second part to be paid, kept and performed, has granted, demised, leased and let by these present do... grant, demise, lease and let unto the said second party... heirs, executors, administrators, successors or assigns, for the sole and only purpose of mining and operating for oil and gas, and of laying pipe lines, and building tanks, powers, station and structures thereon to produce and to take care of said products, all that certain tract of land situate in the County of Butler State of Kansas described as follows, to-wit:

W 1/2 of Sec 7 Township 26 Range 9

of Section 7 Township 26 Range 9 and containing 320 acres, more or less.

It is agreed that this lease shall remain in force for a term of five years from this date and as long thereafter as oil or gas, or either of them, is produced from said land by the party of the second part...

In consideration of the premises the said party of the second part covenants and agrees: 1st. To deliver to the credit of the first party...

2nd. To pay the first part Two Hundred DOLLARS, each year in advance, for the gas from each well where gas only is found, while the same is being used off the premises, and the first part... to have gas free of cost from any such well for all stoves and all inside lights in the principal dwelling house on said land during the same time by making their own connections with the well, or lease line.

3rd. To pay to the first part... for gas produced from any oil well and used off the premises at the rate of Fifty Dollars per year, for the time during which such gas shall be used, said payments to be made each three months in advance.

The party of the second part agrees to complete a well on said premises within One year from the date hereof, or pay at the rate of Fifty Cents per acre, except as to such part of said premises as is surrendered as hereinafter provided...

The party of the second part shall have the right to use, free of cost, gas, oil and water produced on said land for its operation thereon, except water from wells of first party.

When requested by first party, the second party shall bury its pipe lines below plow depth. No well shall be drilled nearer than 300 feet to the house or barn on said premises.

Second party shall pay for damages caused by them to growing crops on said land.

The party of the second part shall have the right at any time to remove all machinery and fixtures placed on said premises, including the right to draw and remove casing.

The party of the second part shall not be bound by any change in the ownership of said land until duly notified of any such change, either by notice in writing duly signed by the parties to the instrument of conveyance, or by receipt of the original instrument of conveyance, or duly certified copy thereof.

All payments which may fall due under this lease may be made by check directly to P.A. Hull and C.C. Higgins... or deposited by Second Party to Citizens State Bank of Ellipton, Kansas

It is agreed that the lessee upon the payment of One Dollar shall have the right to surrender and cancel this lease in toto or as to any part of the premises hereinafter described as the lessee may elect upon filing in the proper recording office a duly executed release thereof and all payments and liabilities provided for herein shall cease and determine except as to such portions of the said premises that the lessee shall at his option elect to retain, provided that in the event any suit or action is brought in any court by the lessee to enforce this lease, then this clause providing for the surrender of this lease by the lessee shall become inoperative immediately and concurrently with the commencement of such suit or action.

This lease, and all provisions herein, shall bind, and run in favor of the respective heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns of the parties hereto.

Upon failure of the lessee to comply with conditions of this lease, or to make any of the payments above provided for delay in completing a well on the date upon which the same become due, the lessor... shall have a right to declare a forfeiture of this lease if such payment be not made within 30 days after written notice to pay the same.
