Dear Mr. Sharp,

As we discussed in our June 15, 2010 meeting concerning wells in the Wilson Creek field, K.A.R. 82-3-111 imposes a 10-year limitation on the amount of time during which wells may be temporarily abandoned, but an exception to the 10-year limitation may be obtained through an application filed with the Commission. In speaking with Mr. Kyle Stevenson, he has indicated that the Vopat D #14 will be included in an application for exception to the 10-year time limit.

District staff does not have the authority to grant exceptions to the 10-year time limitation, therefore this application must be denied due to the length of time the well has been inactive. I spoke with our legal staff and discussed your applications, and informed them that Trans Pacific was working towards making applications on more wells in the Wilson Creek field. Legal staff will allow me to extend the deadline to plug, return the well(s) to service, or seek an exception to the 10-year rule from a 30 day period to a 90 day period. This will give Trans Pacific Oil Corporation a deadline of January 6, 2011 to file for an exception to the 10-year limitation for the above well.


Please visit our website and review the new sample application we have posted on our website. The procedure for filing applications has changed since we last spoke, and the procedure for filing an application for exception to the 10-year rule has changed. Applications will not go before the Commission in a formal hearing, and will now go through an administrative review process. I will leave it up to your staff to decide if you would like to make applications on an individual well basis, lease basis, or the entire field in one application since you now have several approved TA's that will not expire until next year. Please contact me if you have any questions about the new application. Our legal staff will also answer any questions you or your staff may have on filing an application.
