## Dear Mindy Wooten:

District staff has inspected the above referenced location and has determined that the Workover pit shall be constructed **without slots**, the bottom shall be flat and reasonably level, and the free fluids must be removed. The fluids are to be removed from the Workover pit within 4 hours of completion of drilling operations.

## NO completion fluids or non-exempt wastes shall be placed in the Workover pit.

The fluids should be taken to an authorized disposal well. Please call the District Office at (785) 625-0550 when the fluids have been removed. Please file form CDP-5 (August 2008), Exploration and Production Waste Transfer, through KOLAR within 30 days of fluid removal.
