## AHRIDMENT TO POOLING AGREEMENT

HHEREAS, under date of February 10, 1953, OITIES SERVICE OIL COMPANY, a Delaware Corporation with offices in Hartlesville, Oklahoma, as Lessee, and HAX G. WILSON, RAY C. WILSON, INA BELLE HUBLIER, LAURENCE L. WILSON, R. K. CHANBERS, FRANK W. WILSON, FRED D. WILSON, HARKY W. WILSON, DON H. WILSON and MARIE WILSON DAVIS, other wise known as OLIVE WARTE DAVIS, as Lessers, entered into an Agreement unitizing the oil and gas lesses covering the following described land in Butler County, Kansas, to-wit:

The Northeast Cuarter (NE/A) of Section Seven (7), all of Section Right (8) and Heat Half (N/2) of Section Kine (9), Township Twenty-five (25) South, Range Five (5) East,

for the purposes of secondary recovery operations; said Agreement being prapared in counter part and one of which Agreements was filed in Book 191, page 383 or the records of Butler County, Kansas, a copy of which by reference is made a part hereof for all purposes, and

MIMBERS, Cities Service Oil Company has acquired a lease described as follows, to-wit:

Oil and Cas Lease dated January 5, 1916, executed by W. C. Milson et al, Leasor, in favor of J. E. Grosbie, Leases, and recorded in Book N at page 116 of the Records of Butlor County, Kansas, insofar as same covers and applies to the following described land, to-with

West Half of the Southeast Quarter (W/2 SE/4) of Section Nine (9), Tormohip Twenty-Live (25) South, Range Five (5) East, Butler County, Kansas,

MMEREAS, it is the desire of the parties hereto to include said lease in the unit as established by said Agreement of February 10, 1953.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and the mutual covaenants and agraements herein contained the parties hereto have contracted and do contract, atipulate and agree as follows:

I,

The acreage pooled, combined and unitized by the Agreement of Fobruary 10, 1953, is hereby enlarged to include the West Half of the Southeast Quarter (W/2 SB/4) of Section Mino (9), Township Twenty-five (25) South, Range Five (5)

Bast, Butler County, Kansas, effective as of September 1, 1954, so that from and after September 1, 1954, the unitized area shall consist of the following described land, to-wit:

#### III,

All the terms, covenants and conditions of the Agreement of February 10, 1953 are incorporated herein and made a part hereof as if set out fully herein, except as herein emended.

### IV.

This Amendment Agreement may be executed in counterparts, but caid Amendment Agreement chall not become effective unless and until it has been executed by all of the Lessors as set forth in Paragraph II hereof or their successors or assigns. If executed in counterparts, such counterparts chall collectively constitute one Agreement.
