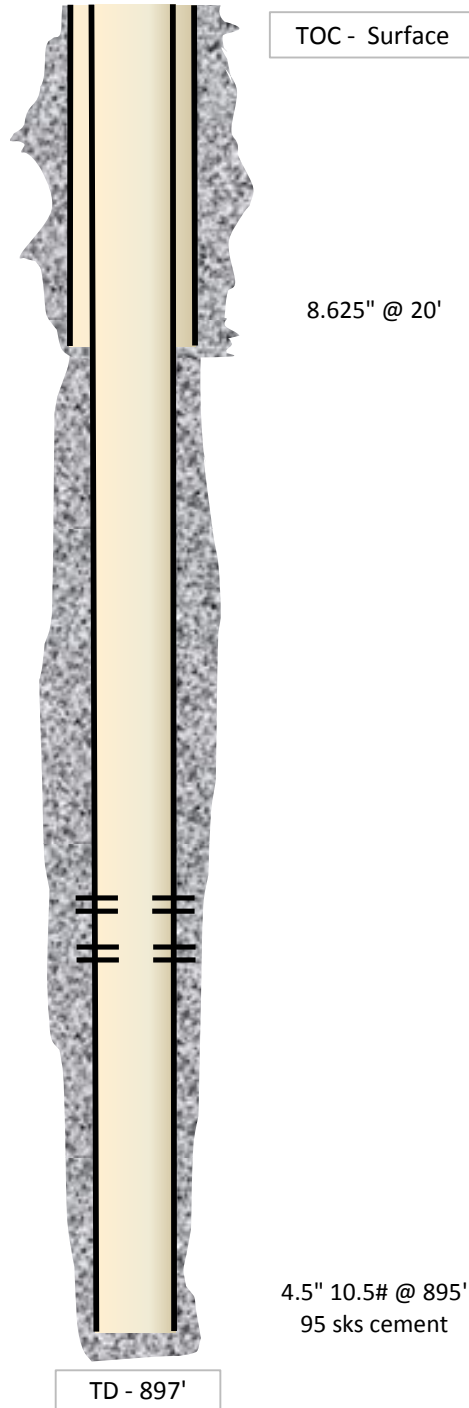

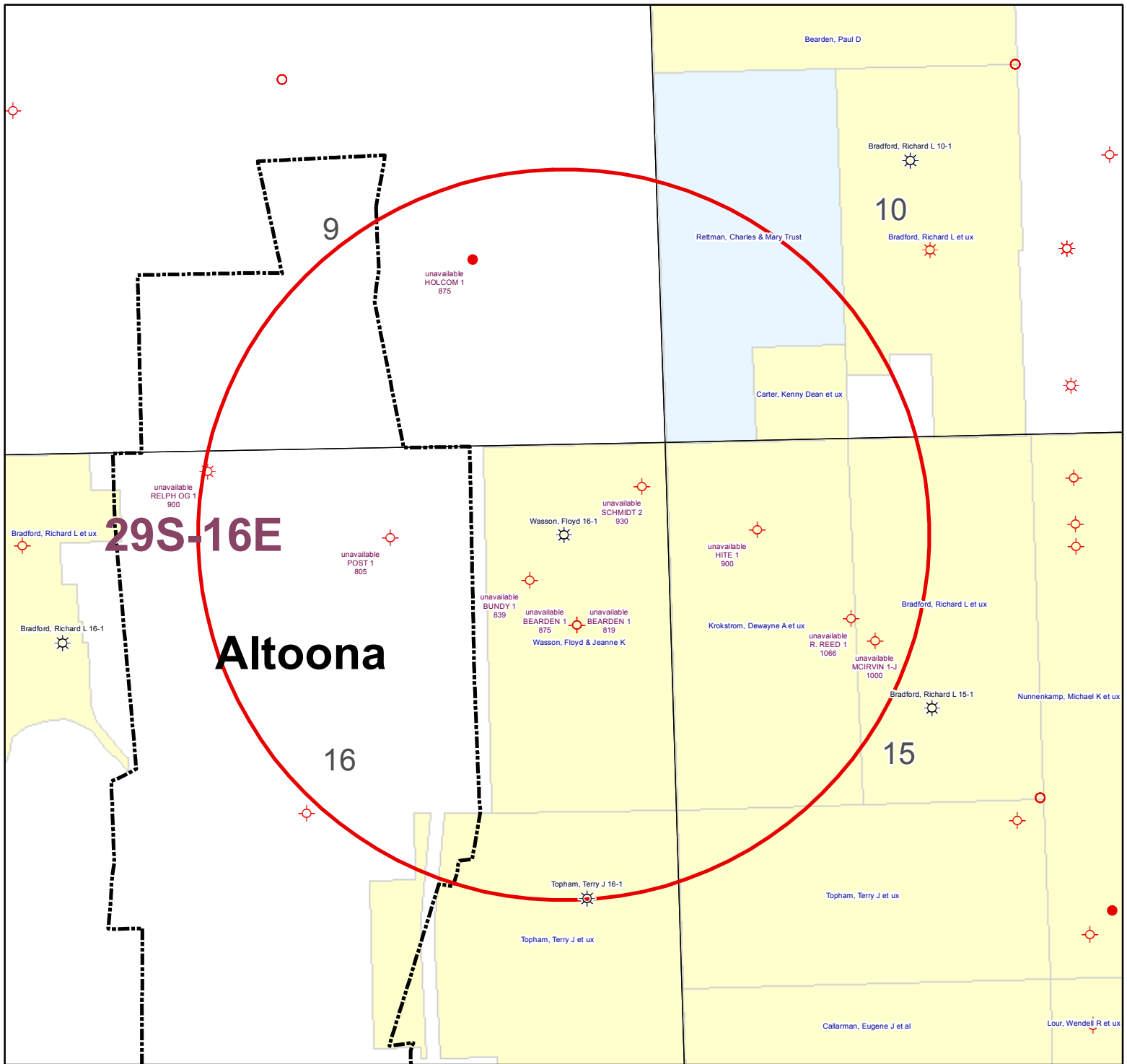


Wellbore Schematic
