**SALTWATER DISPOSAL LEASE**

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into effective March 1, 2011, by  
and between Nelson L. Schwartz, as Trustee of the Irrevocable Trust of Darlyn Kay Schwartz,  
dated July 11, 2005, hereinafter referred to as "Lessor" and Larson Engineering, Inc.,  
hereinafter referred to as "Larson",

WITNESSETH:

That in consideration of the mutual covenants, agreements, and obligations hereinafter  
set forth and to be paid, kept and performed, it is agreed by and between the parties hereto as  
follows:

1. Lessor does hereby lease and let to Larson the sole and exclusive use and right to  
the following described well situated on the lands described herein below:

Schwartz No. 1-17 Salt Water Disposal Well

located at approximately SE SE NW of Sec. 17-18S-29W, containing  
approximately one half (1/2) acre more or less, situated in Lane County, Kansas.

2. Larson shall have full rights of ingress and egress to and from said well over other  
lands of Lessor, for a period of ten (10) years, beginning on March 1, 2011, unless  
sooner terminated as hereinafter provided.

3. Said premises shall be used by Larson for the purpose of drilling, reconditioning,  
erecting, maintaining, using and operating such well, derricks, structures, buildings, tanks,  
pumps, powers, compressors, communication and power lines, pipelines, machinery and other  
equipment as Larson may deem necessary or convenient for subsurface disposal of saltwater  
and other deleterious substances produced in connection with oil and gas leases situated both  
on or off Lessor's properties.

4. Larson is especially granted the right to dispose, by gravity or pressure, saltwater and  
other deleterious substances produced in connection with oil and gas operations, through the  
well subject to this Agreement, into the oil bearing formations or any other strata and formations,  
except fresh-water bearing formations, beneath the surface of any and all of Lessor's lands.

5. The rights, privileges and benefits herein granted to Larson shall be operative with  
respect to all saltwater and other deleterious substances produced in connection with oil and  
gas operations which Larson may desire to dispose of through this disposal well, whether  
produced by Larson or other operators or by both Larson and others.

6. Larson is granted the right at any time, from time to time, during the term of this lease  
to enter upon any portion of Lessor's property situated in the Northwest Quarter (NW/4) of Sec.  
17-18S-29W, Lane County, Kansas, to lay, construct, replace, maintain, use and remove such  
power lines and pipelines as Larson may consider necessary in the operation of its saltwater  
disposal system on the leased premises, and Larson agrees that any such pipelines shall be  
buried to such depths as not to interfere with the ordinary cultivation of such lands. Larson  
agrees to pay for damages caused to growing crops.

7. As full consideration for all the rights, privileges, powers, benefits and options granted  
to Larson hereunder, Larson shall pay to Lessor, in advance, on or before the first day of March  
each year this Agreement remains in force, an annual rental of the sum of five hundred dollars  
(\$500.00) for each oil or gas well utilizing said disposal well. It is understood by the parties that  
the annual rental payment does not apply to wells located on Lessor's lands. It is also  
understood by the parties that the rental obligation on the well will not cease until such time that  
said disposal well is actually plugged and abandoned, otherwise Larson shall continue its rental  
obligation, regardless of whether the disposal well is actually being utilized.

8. All property of any nature or character, owned, erected, installed or placed on the  
above described land by Larson (or its predecessors), whether before or after the date hereof,  
shall be and remain the property of Larson and Larson shall have the right, but shall not be  
obligated, to sever and remove the same at any time during the continuance, and within 180  
days after the termination of this Lease or any extension thereof.

9. This lease shall constitute a covenant running with the land and shall extend to, be binding upon, and inure to the benefit of, the heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns of Lessor and the successors and assigns of Larson, but no change in the ownership of the above-described lands or of the right to receive the payments hereunder, whether by voluntary act of the parties or otherwise shall be binding upon Larson until it has been notified thereof and been furnished with proper evidence of such transfer.

10. Nothing herein contained shall be construed as modifying, amending, or affecting the terms and provisions of any valid and subsisting oil and gas lease covering the above-described land.


