

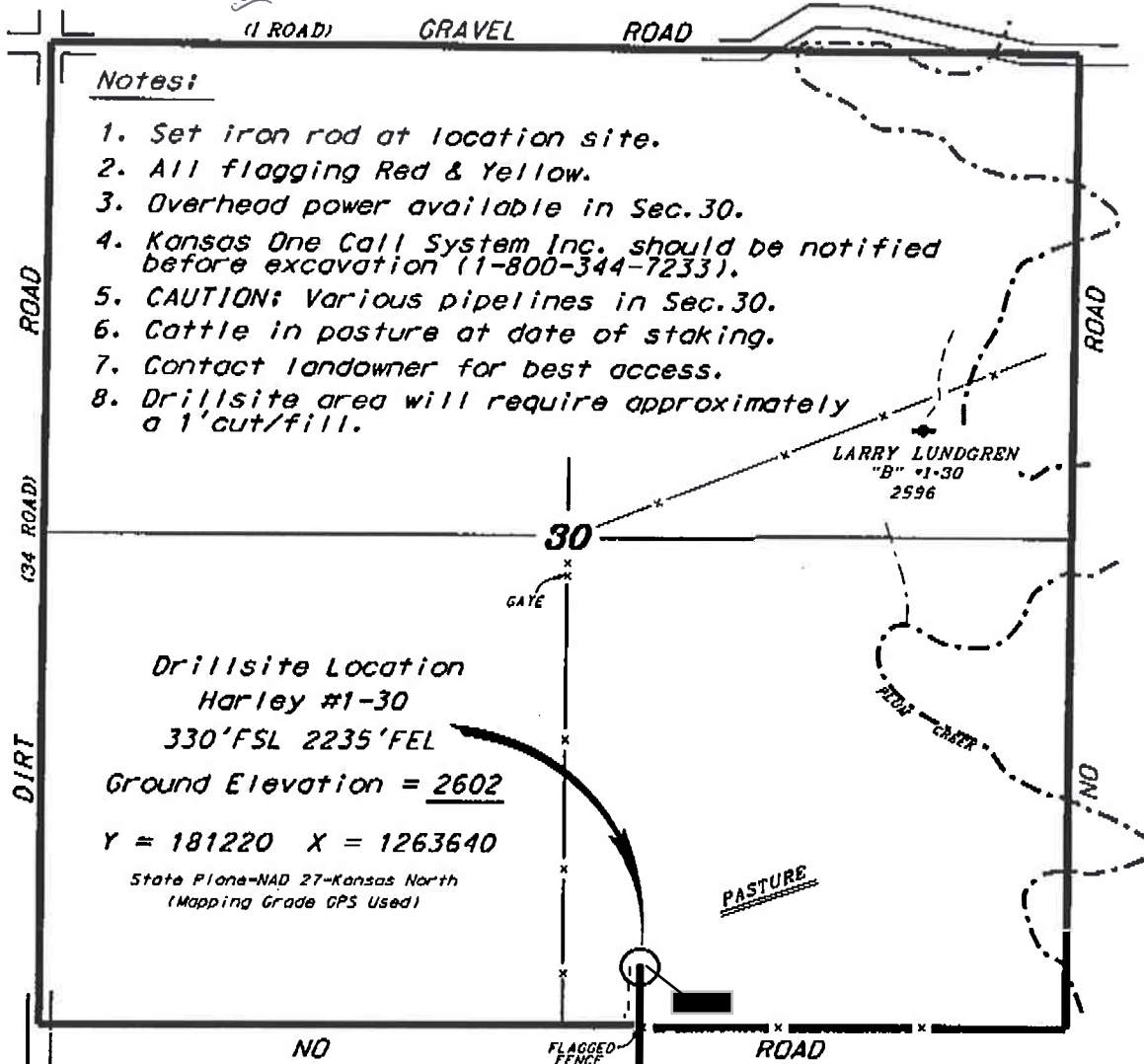
**L.D. DRILLING, INC.**

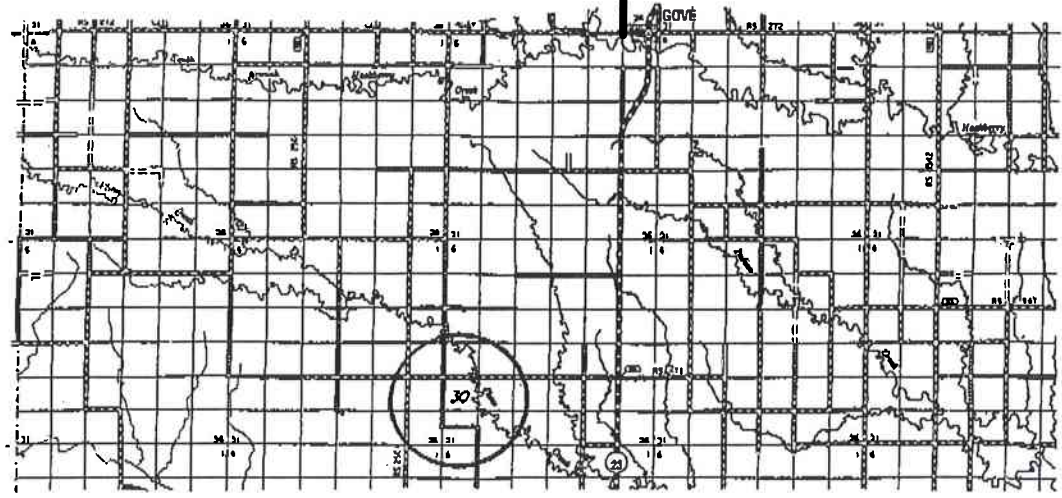
**Notes:**

7. Contact landowner for best access.
8. Drillsite area will require approximately a 1' cut/fill.
