HAUL-OFF PIT APPLICATION FILING REQUIREMENTS

- (a) Each operator shall perform one of the following when disposing of dike or pit contents:
 - (1) Remove the liquid contents to a disposal well or other oil and gas operation approved by the commission or to road maintenance or construction locations approved by the department;
 - (2) dispose of reserve pit waste down the annular space of a well completed according to the alternate I requirements of K.A.R. 82-3-106, if the waste to be disposed of was generated during the drilling and completion of the well; or
 - (3) dispose of the remaining solid contents in any manner required by the commission. The requirements may include any of the following:
 - (A) Burial in place, in accordance with the grading and restoration requirements in K.A.R. 82-3-602 (f);
 - (B) removal and placement of the contents in an on-site disposal area approved by the commission;
 - (C) removal and placement of the contents in an off-site disposal area on acreage owned by the same landowner or to another producing lease or unit operated by the same operator, if prior written permission from the landowner has been obtained; or
 - (D) removal of the contents to a permitted off-site disposal area approved by the department.
- (b) Each violation of this regulation shall be punishable by the following:
 - (1) A \$1,000 penalty for the first violation;
 - (2) a \$2.500 penalty for the second violation; and
 - (3) a \$5,000 penalty and an operator license review for the third violation.



Directions: From the Northeast side of Garden City, Ks by Wal-Mart, at the intersection of Hwy 156 & Hwy 50, overpass bridge - Now go 0.8 mile NE on Hwy 156 – Now go 4 miles North on Jennie Barker Rd. to the SE corner of section 16-23s-32w – Now go 0.5 mile North on Jennie Barker Rd.to ingress West into – Now go 0.2 mile West on trail to ingress stake West into – Now go approx. 830' West and NW through grass to ingress stake North into – Now go approx. 470' North through irr. corn stubble, into staked location.

Final ingress must be verified with land owner or Operator.

Dear Evan Mayhew:

District staff has inspected the above referenced location and has determined that the Haul-Off pit shall be constructed <u>without slots</u>, the bottom shall be flat and reasonably level, and the free fluids must be removed. The fluids are to be removed from the Haul-Off pit within 96 hours of completion of drilling operations.

NO completion fluids or non-exempt wastes shall be placed in the Haul-Off pit.

The fluids should be taken to an authorized disposal well. Please call the District Office at (620) 225-8888 when the fluids have been removed. Please file form CDP-5 (August 2008), Exploration and Production Waste Transfer, through KOLAR within 30 days of fluid removal.
