

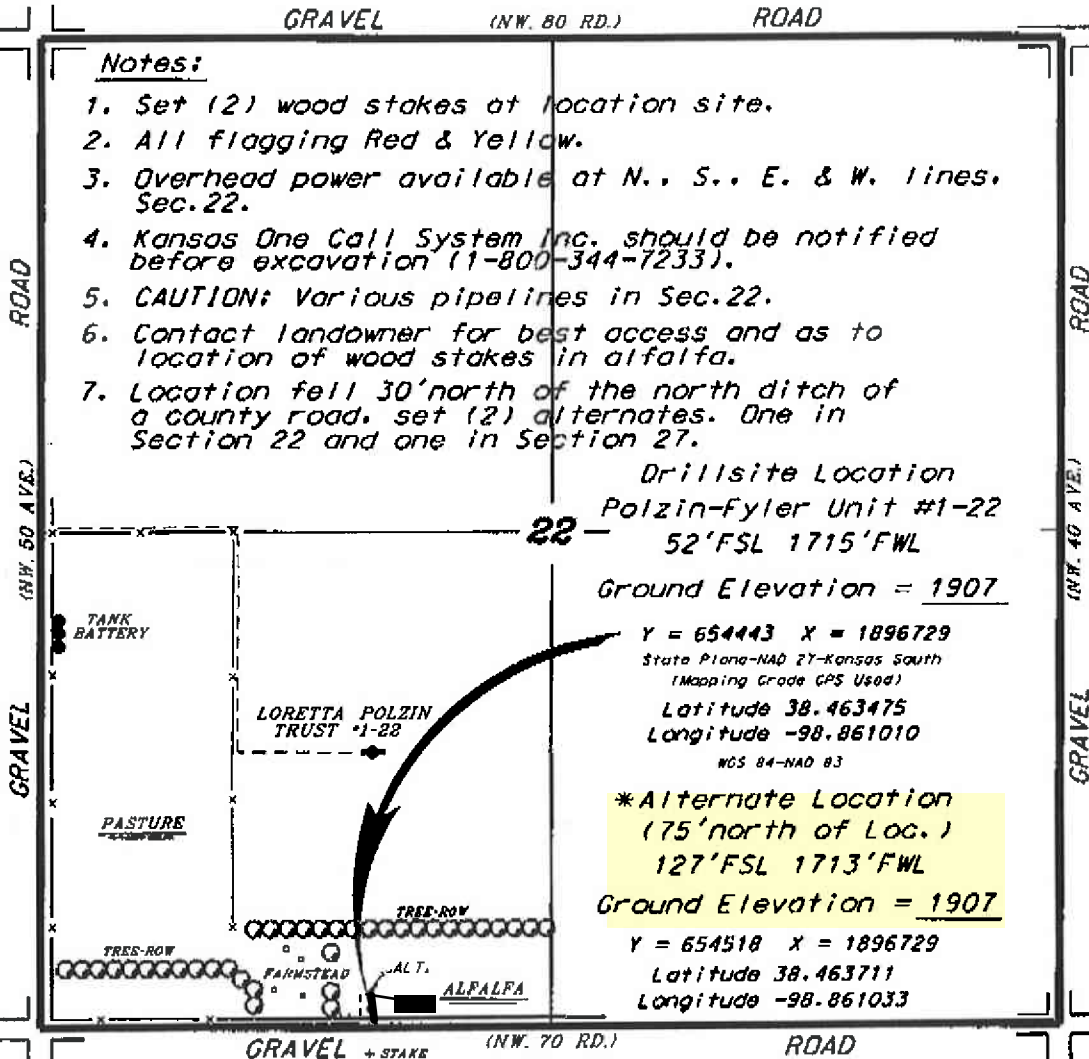

 From the intersection of Highway 281 and Highway 4 11.0 miles north & 3.0 miles west of Hoisington, KS. 1 go 5.0 miles South to the SE. corner of Section 22, then go 0.67 miles West, then go 0.009 miles North to location.

**Notes:**

1. Set (2) wood stakes at location site.
2. All flagging Red & Yellow.
3. Overhead power available at N., S., E. & W. lines. Sec. 22.
4. Kansas One Call System Inc. should be notified before excavation (1-800-344-7233).
5. CAUTION; Various pipelines in Sec. 22.
6. Contact landowner for best access and as to location of wood stakes in alfalfa.
7. Location fell 30' north of the north ditch of a county road, set (2) alternates. One in Section 22 and one in Section 27.



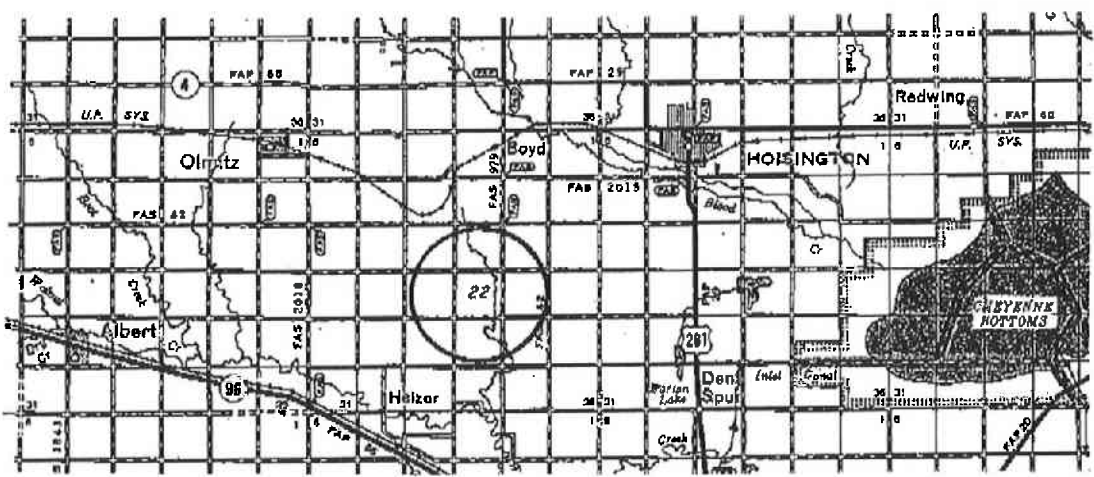
Drillsite Location
