From the intersection of Highway 183 and Interstate 70 (at the north edge of Hays, Kansas) go 14.0 miles North on Highway 183, then go 6.5 miles East, then go 2.0 miles South to the SE. corner of Section 22, then go 0.31 miles West, then go 0.08 miles North to location.

1. Set iron rod at location site.
2. All flagging Red & Yellow.
3. Overhead power available at E. line, E.1/2 of N. line and E.1/2 of S. line, Sec.22.
4. Kansas One Call System Inc. should be notified before excavation (1-800-344-7233).
5. CAUTION: Various pipelines in Sec.22.
6. Cattle in area at date of staking.
7. Found old well per magnetic response.
8. Contact landowner for best access.
9. Drillsite area will require approximately a 3'cut/fill.
10. Location fell 20' SE. of a NE-SW overhead electric service line. no alternate set.

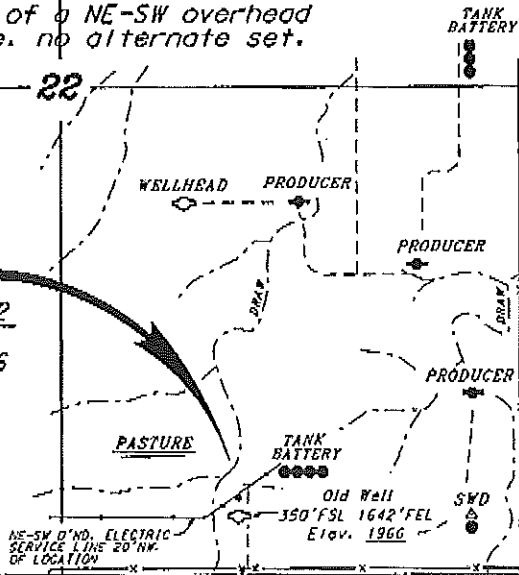

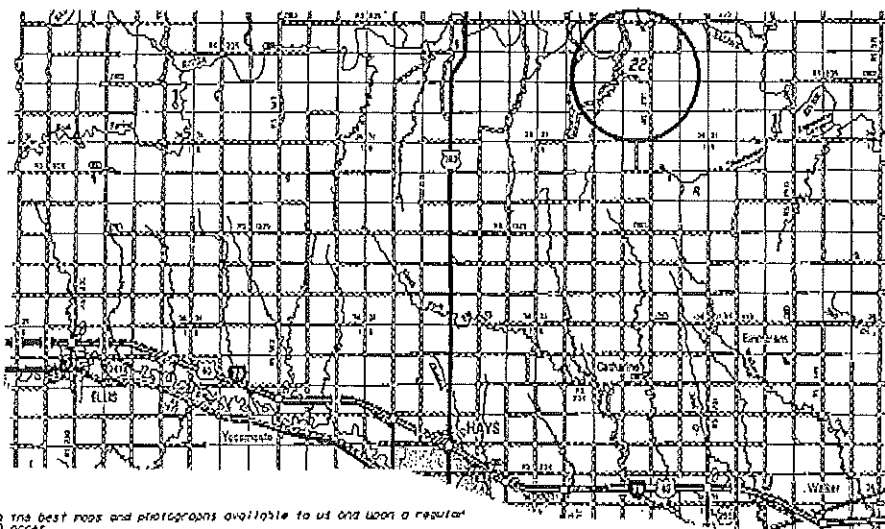
