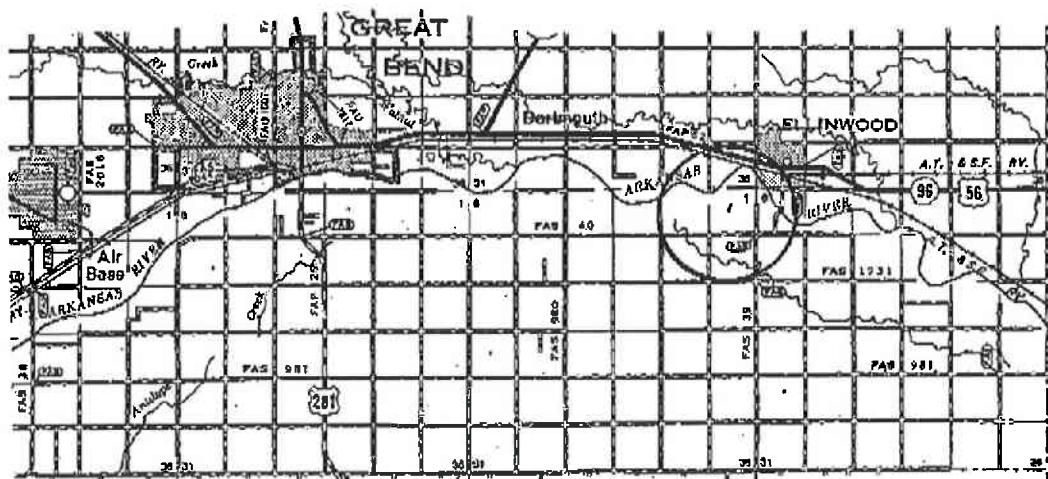
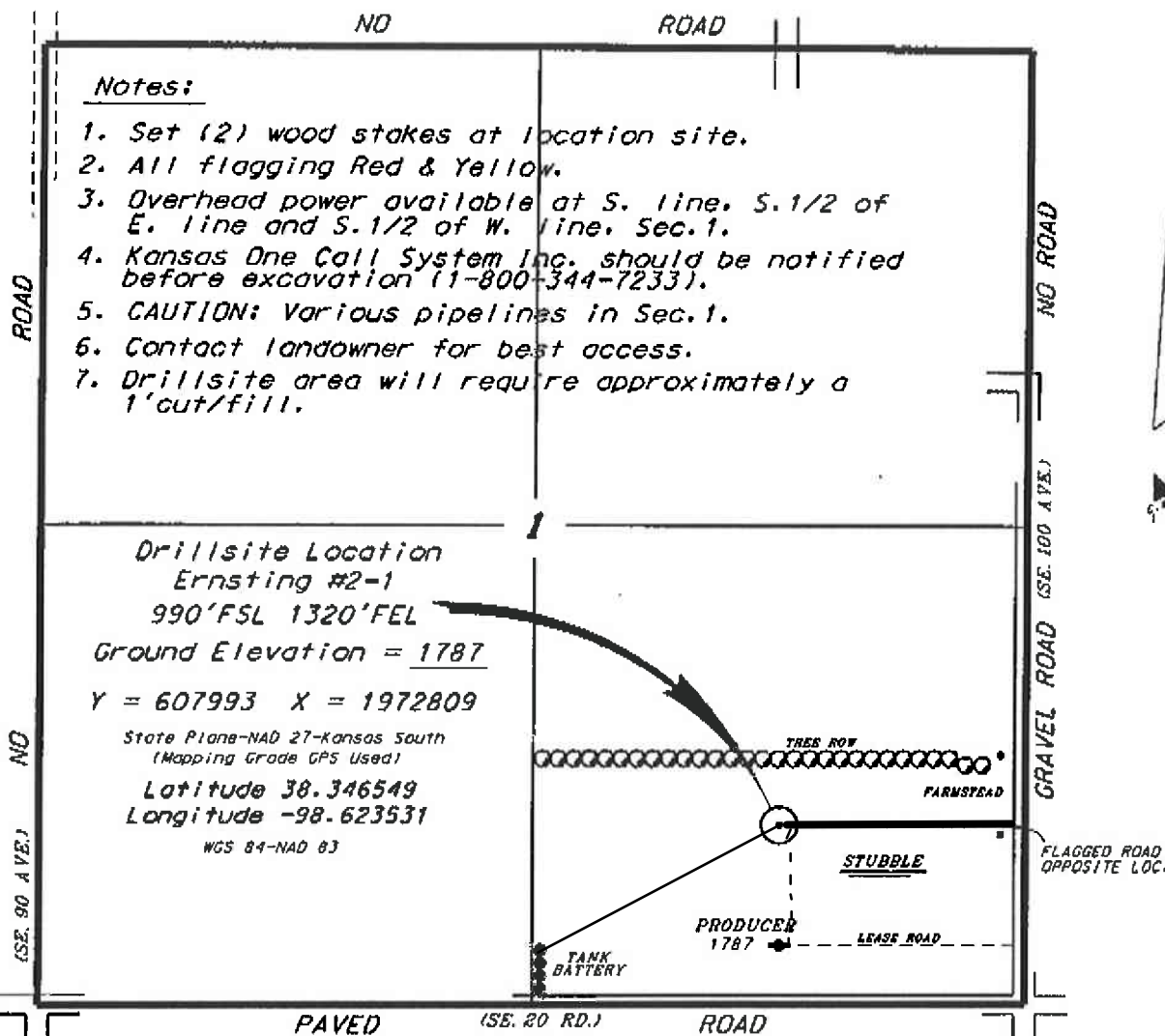
1. Set (2) wood stakes at location site.
