Syracuse #10 CB Well Abandonment, API #15-075-19003-0000

Abandonment of old cathodic protection well will occur 320 feet south of Rd 25 centerline and 30 feet west of the section-line road center line. The well location has no above ground marker for location and will not have one after it is abandoned. We will construct 10' L x 3' W x 8' D drilling pit beside the well and fill with only potable water. A rotary mud drilling rig will enter the well with drill pipe to flush out any remaining backfill, anodes, wire, and 1" PVC vent line to the holes total depth. The hole will then be sealed by pumping neat cement into the well starting at the hole bottom. Cement pumping will continue into the well until the well is filled to the casing top. The PVC casing will then receive a permanent Sch 40 PVC cap 3-4 feet below grade. Backfilling of the well abandonment site will occur. The drilling pit will be left open for a few days to allow for drying while we drill the new well 100 feet east. It will then be backfilled and the land surface will be returned to its pre-construction elevation.

Dear Steve Mitchell:

The Conservation Division has received your Well Plugging Application (CP-1).

Under K.A.R. 82-3-113(b)(2), you must notify DISTRICT 1 of your proposed plugging plan at least 5 days before plugging the well. DISTRICT 1's phone number is (620) 682-7933. Failure to notify DISTRICT 1, or failure to file a Well Plugging Record (CP-4) after the well is plugged will result in a penalty recommendation.

Under K.A.R. 82-3-600, you must file an Application for Surface Pit (CDP-1) if you wish to use a workover pit while plugging the well. Failure to timely file a CDP-1, failure to timely remove fluids, or failure to timely file Closure of Surface Pit (CDP-4) or Waste Transfer (CDP-5) forms will result in a penalty recommendation.

This receipt does NOT constitute authorization to plug this well if you do not otherwise have the legal right to do so.

This receipt is VOID after December 07, 2018. If the well is not plugged by then, you will have to submit a new CP-1 if you wish to plug the well.

The December 07, 2018 deadline does NOT override any compliance deadline given to you by Legal, District, or other Commission Staff. Failure to comply with any given deadline will still result in the Commission assessing penalties, or taking other legal action.
