







Proposed WBD for Hayward Farms 18-1 – Dual Completion


- Deeper perforations (Morrow) will flow up the tubing string to the surface and go to it's own separate meter-run coming off of the tubing.
- The shallow perforations (Chase) will be isolated on the backside from the deep perforations with a packer set at 2967'. This shallow gas will flow up the casing/backside to the surgace and go to it's own separate meter-run coming off of the casing/annulus.
- Once each zone's gas has been individually meter'd, each zonal gas will flow past a separate check meter and then go down the same gathering line/system.
