Larry,

As we discussed last week this waste is not categorized as special waste. The waste originates from the drilling operation of boreholes used for cathodic protection. The waste is a slurry consisting of water and native soil.

Because the waste does not pass the paint filter it cannot directly be disposed at the working face without thickening.

I understand that you propose to dump this waste in a small earthen basin located by the soil stockpile for drying and thickening. Once thickened and mixed with soil it can be used as daily cover.

This email will serve as the BWM's approval for the proposed method of dealing with this drilling waste.
