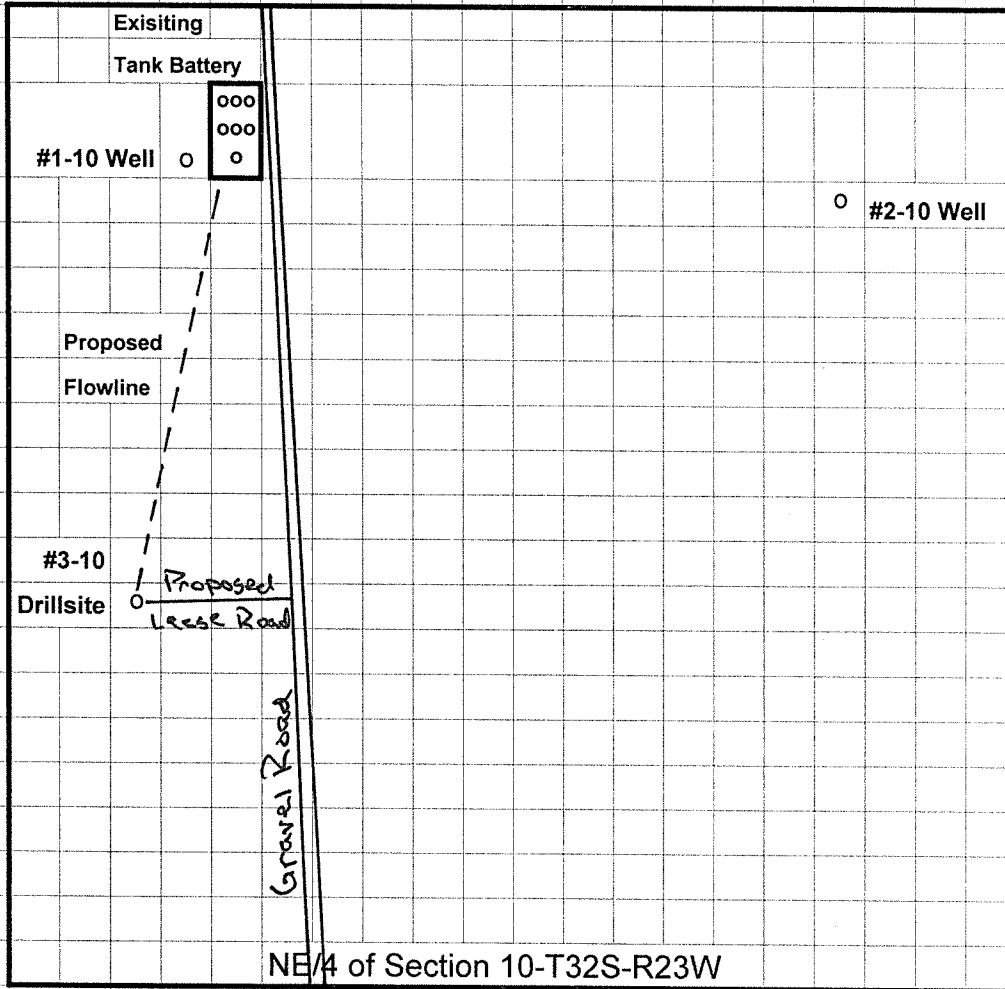


Mull Drilling Company, Inc.
Proposed Location of Roads, Lines and Tank Battery

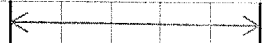

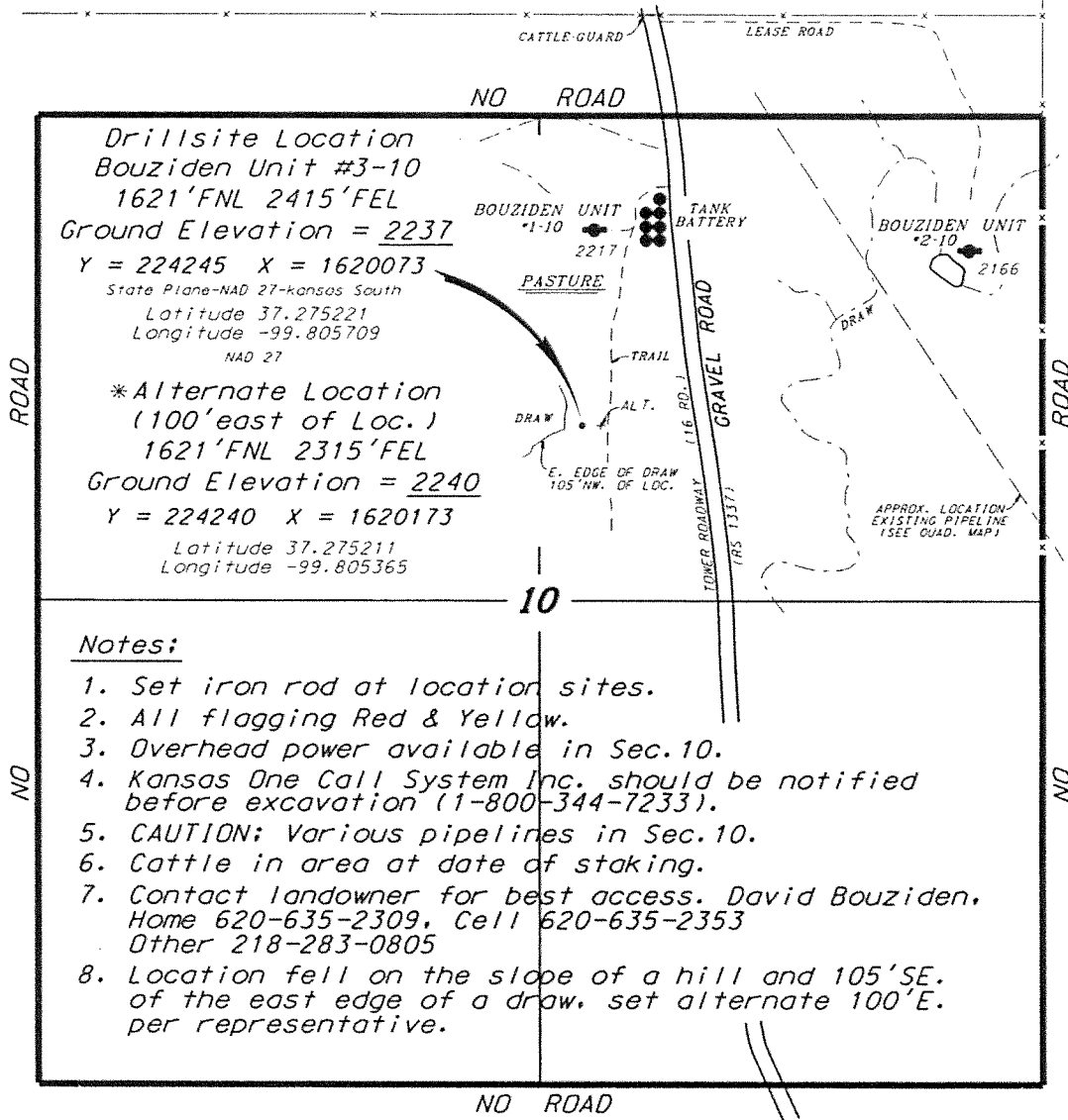

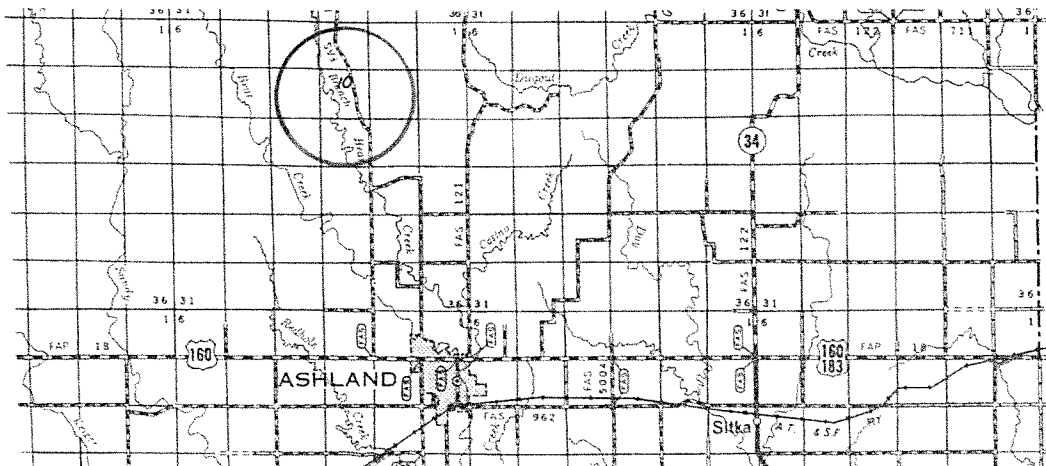
From the intersection of Highway 160 and 19 road (at the NW. corner of Ashland, Ks.) go 1.0 miles West, then go 5.97 miles North to a lease road entrance at north side of tank battery, then go 0.32 miles southwest along a trail to location.



Notes:

1. Set iron rod at location sites.
2. All flagging Red & Yellow.
3. Overhead power available in Sec. 10.
4. Kansas One Call System Inc. should be notified before excavation (1-800-344-7233).
5. CAUTION; Various pipelines in Sec. 10.
6. Cattle in area at date of staking.
