The undersigned hereby affirms that the drilling, completion and eventual plugging of this well will comply with K.S.A. 55 et. seq.

It is agreed that the following minimum requirements will be met:

1. Notify the appropriate district office **prior** to spudding of well;
2. A copy of the approved notice of intent to drill **shall be** posted on each drilling rig;
3. The minimum amount of surface pipe as specified below **shall be set** by circulating cement to the top; in all cases surface pipe **shall be set** through all unconsolidated materials plus a minimum of 20 feet into the underlying formation.
4. If the well is dry hole, an agreement between the operator and the district office on plug length and placement is necessary **prior to plugging**;
5. The appropriate district office will be notified before well is either plugged or production casing is cemented in;
6. If an ALTERNATE II COMPLETION, production pipe shall be cemented from below any usable water to surface within **120 DAYS** of spud date. Or pursuant to Appendix "B" - Eastern Kansas surface casing order #133,891-C, which applies to the KCC District 3 area, alternate II cementing must be completed within 30 days of the spud date or the well shall be plugged. **In all cases, NOTIFY district office** prior to any cementing.

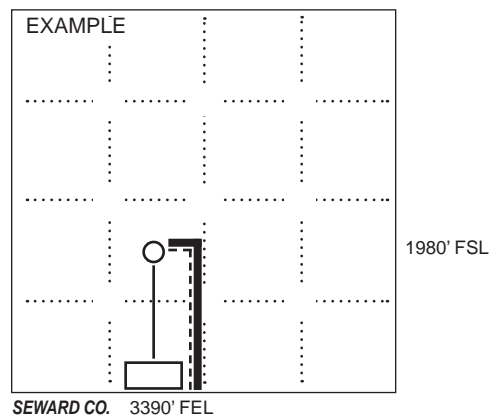

Mr. Hestermann,

I have a prospect in the E/2 of section 26 T21s-R16E in Coffee County Kansas. The prospect is based on an old core test map. While this core test map identifies a small structure, the data is incomplete to define the prospect in enough detail. It is my desire to drill additional core tests to the Lansing Limestone at approximately 300 feet of depth. Run 2 7/8" tubing in the hole and run a cased hole log to identify the Lansing lime compared to sea level elevation. This would allow me to add detail to the old core drill map, then I could drill the higher points on the anticline.

I am requesting an exception from the requirement to set and cement surface casing. The procedure I am requesting is to drill the 300' with a 5+" PDC bit which would take about 3 hours, then run 2 7/8" tubing in the hole and run the cased hole log which would take about 2 hours. Once logged, we would pull the 2 7/8" casing out of the hole while pumping cement to plug the hole with a continuous cement plug from TD to surface, which would take about an hour.

To drill, log and plug the core holes will take about 8 hours start to finish. I anticipate drilling 2 to 4 of these core test wells to further define the prospect.

Please let me know if this procedure will be acceptable to the KCC.

Dear Mr. Pryor:

The Kansas Corporation Commission (KCC) has received your request for an exception to the Table 1 minimum surface pipe requirement of 40 feet for the proposed core tests in Coffey County. From your request, the KCC understands that Black Star 231 Corp. is requesting to drill up to four tests to a depth of approximately 300'. Tubing will then be run into the well and logs run. The tubing will then be pulled and the well will be plugged with cement from total depth to surface. It is anticipated that each well will be drilled and plugged the same day they are spud.

After review of this matter by technical staff it was determined that:

1. Bedrock at this location is the Douglas Group and is located at or near surface.
2. The depth of the nearest water well of record within one mile of the proposed location is 51 feet.

Based on this information, an exception is granted for the Table 1 Minimum Surface Casing Requirements with the following stipulations:

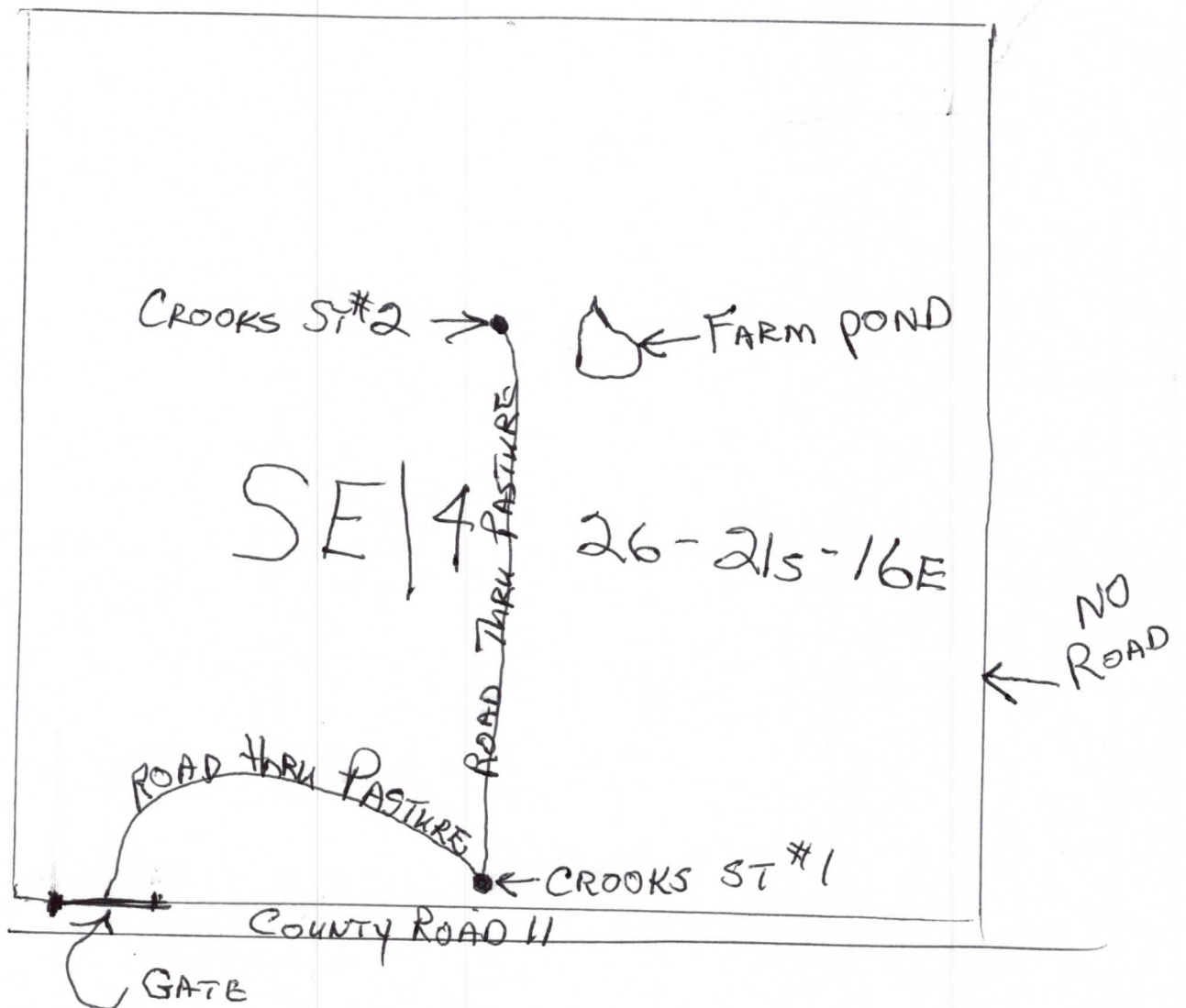
1. An Intent to Drill (C1CPD1) must be filed and approved for each test hole location.
2. The KCC District #3 office must be notified at least 48 hours prior to spudding the wells so they have the opportunity to witness the drilling and plugging procedure.

Dear Jim Pryor:

District staff has inspected the above referenced location and has determined that the reserve pit shall be constructed **without slots**, the bottom shall be flat and reasonably level, and the free fluids must be removed. The fluids are to be removed from the reserve pit as soon as practical after drilling operations have ceased.

**If production casing is set all completion fluids shall be removed from the working pits daily. NO completion fluids or non-exempt wastes shall be placed in the reserve pit.**

The fluids should be taken to an authorized disposal well. Please call the District Office at (620) 902-6450 when the fluids have been removed. Please file form CDP-5 (August 2008), Exploration and Production Waste Transfer, through KOLAR within 30 days of fluid removal.
