Grades from Kansas State's victory at Baylor and a look ahead to West Virginia

WACO, TEXAS

This was arguably Kansas State's most impressive victory of the season. Baylor was playing its best football of the year and the Bears were riding a three-game winning streak entering Saturday's matchup, but they were no match for the Wildcats in a 31-3 blowout that was never close after the first quarter. K-State (7-3, 5-2 Big 12) also thoroughly dominated Oklahoma State, 48-0, and made Missouri look like an FCS team earlier this year, but the Cowboys were dealing with myriad injuries and the Tigers had to play the Wildcats in the middle of a thunderstorm. Both those games were also at home.

There were no such qualifiers to explain this result. K-State was flat out better than Baylor, and it showed in every phase of the game. For that reason, the Wildcats are now in control of their own destiny in the Big 12 championship race and the Bears are not.

Let's look back on the action from Saturday and hand out a few awards and grades, as well as look ahead to next week's game against West Virginia.

PLAY OF THE GAME

Will Howard found K-State tight end Ben Sinnott with a beautiful touchdown pass in the second quarter that only a handful of quarterbacks in the nation could have thrown.

Sinnott appeared to be triple covered in the end zone. Baylor defenders surrounded him in every direction, but there was a tiny window between them and Howard impressively squeezed the football into it for six points.

PLAYER OF THE GAME

Ben Sinnott: It was a tough call between Deuce Vaughn, Howard and Sinnott. They all played great against the Bears. But the K-State tight end gets the nod because he delivered the most highlights.

He caught seven passes for 89 yards and two touchdowns.

Some thought the Wildcats weren't going to have a versatile tight end capable of stretching the field as a pass-catcher this season, but Sinnott is doing exactly that. Later, he has been playing like an All-Big 12 candidate.

His first touchdown was a thing of beauty. His second score was pure athleticism, when he beat a Baylor defender by high-pointing the ball like Randy Moss.

STAT OF THE GAME

How about 103? As in the Bears only rushed for 103 yards.

K-State limited Baylor's rushing attack in ways that other Big 12 teams haven't this season. The Bears ran for more than 200 yards in each of their past three games and then encountered a brick wall against K-State's defensive front.

QUOTE TO NOTE

"This is a great win be-

cause I know how hard it is to win here. I've just got so much respect for Dave Aranda. He's one of my favorite coaches. He does things the right way. We're trying to emulate a lot of the things that they do, honestly." — Chris Kleinman.

KANSAS STATE FOOTBALL GRADES

Offense: A+ Will Howard once again played like an All-American, throwing for 196 yards and three touchdowns. Ben Sinnott had the best game of his college career at tight end. Deuce Vaughn did whatever he wanted on his way to 156 all-purpose yards and a touchdown. The Wildcats finished with 31 points and 405 yards. Howard seems like the obvious choice to start at quarterback moving forward. He is playing at a higher level than Adrian Martinez.

Defense: A+ This was a masterpiece from K-State's defense. Baylor only managed three points and 306 yards. Austin Moore led the way with eight tackles and Daniel Green looked like his old self while making six tackles. After dealing with injuries, he said he is now fully healthy. Would you believe this was the fourth time that K-State held an opponent without a touchdown this season?

Special Teams: A Ty Zentner connected on his only field goal attempt and also did some nice things as a punter and a kickoff specialist.

Coaching: A+ On paper, it seemed like Baylor

had some advantages over K-State in this matchup, but none of them showed up on the field. The Wildcats were ready to go from the start on defense and were humming on offense with Howard in the game. This was a massive turnaround from last week's home loss against Texas.

NEXT UP

K-State will return to action at 1 p.m. next Saturday against the West Virginia Mountaineers. The game will be streamed on ESPN.

The Wildcats figure to be favored in that game, but it won't be an easy road trip for them.

West Virginia (4-6, 2-5) has struggled mightily away from Milan Puskar Stadium this season, going 1-4 without a single road win in conference play. But Neal Brown's team has been difficult to beat at home. The Mountaineers are 3-2 at home with victories over Baylor and Oklahoma.

The Mountaineers are coming off a 23-20 victory over the Sooners in which they rallied from a late deficit and won on a last-minute field goal.

West Virginia has been a tricky place for K-State to play of late. It hasn't beaten the Mountaineers on the road since 2014.

Grades from KU Jayhawks' loss to Texas Tech and looking ahead to Texas

Here are our letter grades for all three Kansas units, plus our play of the game from Saturday's 43-28 loss to Texas Tech at Jones AT&T Stadium in Lubbock, Texas — plus a look ahead to the next game, Saturday vs. Texas at David Booth Kansas Memorial Stadium.

PLAY OF THE GAME

Kansas senior quarterback Jason Bean fired a perfect pass to wide receiver Quentin Skinner for a 20-yard touchdown with 8:06 to play.

That TD, which capped a six-play, 60-yard drive, cut a 12-point deficit to 33-28 during crunch time. On a third and goal call from back at the 20, Bean accepted the snap in the shotgun, took a couple steps back and one step to his left. Under pressure from the Texas Tech pass rush, Bean misread to his right and, once he reached the 21-yard line, drilled a bullet to the right corner of the end zone to Skinner, who was able to plant a foot in bound.

Skinner, a 6-foot-5, 190-pound redshirt sophomore from Claremore, Okla., had three catches for 29 yards.

KU FOOTBALL GRADES

Offense: A- Kansas gained 525 total yards. Considering that type of production, one might expect more than 28 points.

KU again moved the football with great proficiency. Bean completed 17 of 28 passes for 270 yards and three touchdowns — passes to Jared Casey (66 yards), Luke Grimm (33) and Skinner (20). Bean also had a highlight-reel 16-yard run for a touchdown. That run started KU's comeback from a 24-7 deficit.

Running back Devin Neal rushed for 190 yards

on 24 carries, topping out with a carry for 63 yards. He averaged 7.9 yards per carry. Ky Thomas had a 40-yard run late on his only carry.

Tight end Mason Fairchild had five catches for 49 yards and receiver Lawrence Arnold made four catches for 110 yards, including a catch and run of 60 yards.

Defense: C

Texas Tech put up a total of 510 yards and scored 43 points.

Quarterback Tyler Shough was 20-of-33 passing for 246 yards and one TD. He rushed for 16 yards on 12 carries and a score. That rushing TD stretched a six-point lead to 33-21 early in the fourth quarter. Running back SaRodrick Thompson had 68 yards on seven carries and a TD and RB CamRon Valdez went for 66 yards on 11 carries.

Tech had 264 rushing yards on 48 carries. Ten of Texas Tech's points came following Kansas turnovers, including a fumble late in the fourth quarter. Kenny Logan had 11 tackles, including eight solo stops. Taiwan Berryhill had eight tackles.

Special teams: D

Jacob Borcia missed field goal tries of 41 and 37 yards. He did convert four extra points. Tabor Allen drilled four kickoffs (out of five total) for touchbacks. Reis Vernon punted two times for a 48.0-yard average.

UP NEXT FOR KANSAS FOOTBALL

KU will play host to Texas on Saturday at David Booth Kansas Memorial Stadium. The time of the game has been set for 2:30 p.m. The game will be aired on FS1.

Texas is 6-4 overall and 4-3 in the Big 12 after Saturday's 17-10 loss to TCU in Austin, Texas.

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How Kansas State can earn a berth in Big 12 championship game

WACO, TEXAS

The Kansas State football team has regained control of its own destiny in the Big 12 championship race.

K-State (7-3, 5-2 Big 12) surged ahead of both Baylor (6-4, 4-3) and Texas (6-4, 4-3) in the conference standings on Saturday following an impressive 31-3 victory over the Bears. The Wildcats entered the weekend needing help, in the form of a clear path to the league title game on Dec. 3 at AT&T Stadium, and they got it when TCU beat the Longhorns, 17-10.

TCU (10-0, 7-0) clinched a spot in the conference championship game with its victory. The second spot remains up for grabs, but K-State has

the inside track.

The path is simple. The Wildcats can make it to Arlington, Texas, by winning each of their final two games against West Virginia and Kansas. It doesn't matter what else happens after the conference. Two more wins and K-State is in. The Wildcats don't need any help if they finish the regular season with two more victories.

But that is not the only way K-State can reach the league title game. There is also a scenario in which K-State could clinch a spot in the Big 12 championship with just one more victory, and it could happen as early as next week. If the Wildcats go on the road and defeat West Virginia next weekend, they can celebrate a second-place finish if Texas falls at Kansas.

In that scenario, K-State would have a two-game lead over Texas and Kan-

sas with one game to play. The Wildcats would also have at least a one-game lead (plus tiebreakers) over Baylor and Oklahoma State (7-3, 4-3).

Things will become more complicated for K-State if it loses its next game against West Virginia. That would open the door for Texas to regain an advantage in the championship mix heading into its final game of the regular season against Baylor. The Bears and Cowboys and Jayhawks would also suddenly have new life if they win. The Sunflower Showdown could have Big 12 championship implications in that scenario.

For now, though, the path is clear.

No one can stop the Wildcats from playing for a conference title if they keep winning.

Based upon the depth of the St. Louis formation perforations, total oil production shall not exceed 200 BOPD and total gas production shall not exceed 50% of the absolute open flow (AOF).
