MEMORANDUM OF SALE AND PURCHASE AGREEMENT

FOR VALUABLE CONSIDERATION, **Crude Kin Oil Co.**, a Kansas corporation, 12235 W. 255th Street, Louisburg, KS 66053 ("Seller"), did by unrecorded written instrument, agree to sell the following described oil and gas leases and all personal property and equipment located thereon to **Miami county Production Ilc**, a Kansas limited liability company, P.O. Box 6, Paola, KS 66071 ("Buyer"):

The purchase price and the terms of the sale have been agreed upon and reduced to writing by the above named parties. During executory period of the aforesaid Purchase and Sale Agreement, the above named Parties have agreed that Seller may not release the above referenced leases, pledge or encumber said leases, or otherwise convey said oil and gas leases or the personal property located thereon to any other party.


During the term of the aforesaid Purchase and Sale Agreement, Buyer shall have the right to operate said oil and gas leases or designate the operator of said oil and gas leases and perform any and all acts that could be performed by the Lessee of said oil and gas lease, and all moneys payable to the working interest owned by Seller shall be paid 50% to **Miami county Production Ilc** and 50% to Crude Kin Oil Co., by any crude oil purchaser during the term of the Purchase and Sale Agreement. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the foregoing, Buyer shall not sell any pump jacks or injection equipment on the leases without Seller's written consent during the executory period of the Purchase Sale Agreement and Buyer shall cause all Leases to continue to produce in paying quantities at all times during such time.

All future tax statements attributable to the working interest of the above referenced leases for the 2025 and later tax years should be sent to **Miami county Production Ilc**, a Kansas limited liability company, P.O. Box 6, Paola, KS 66071.

This Memorandum is recorded for the purpose of providing notice to all third parties that Buyer, hold certain rights and interests in the above described property and oil and gas leases. The above referenced Purchase and Sale Agreement is binding upon the parties successors and assigns.

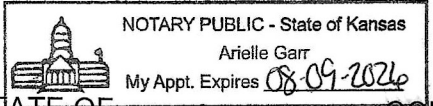

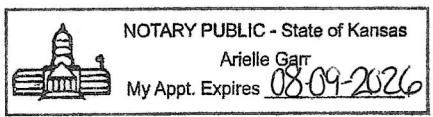
