KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That

WHEREAS, on the 13th day of April, 2026 in the District Court in and for the County of Miami and State of Kansas, in a certain action then pending in said Court, Case No. MI-2025-CV-000180, wherein Tom's Oilfield Services, Inc. was Plaintiff and Excel Oil and Gas, LLC, a Kansas limited liability company, GN Bank, N.A., a national banking association, and Outdoor Bank, a Kansas banking association, were Defendants, a judgment was entered in favor of the Plaintiff, Tom's Oilfield Services, Inc., foreclosing its lien and executing upon judgment entered in said Court in Case No. MI-2024-CV-000111, and in favor of Defendants GN Bank and Outdoor Bank foreclosing their Mortgages, against Defendant Excel Oil and Gas, LLC in the sums set forth in a Journal Entry of Default Judgment filed on April 13, 2026;

WHEREAS, it was then and there in said action, by the Court, further considered, ordered and adjudged that should said judgment not be paid by Defendant Excel Oil and Gas, LLC within fourteen (14) days from entry of the Journal Entry of Default Judgment, then in said event that an Order of Sale be issued by the Court and directed to the undersigned Sheriff of Miami County, Kansas commanding the sale of all interest of Defendant Excel Oil and Gas, LLC in and to the Oil and Gas Leases hereinafter described in the manner prescribed by law;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Order of Sale issued and directed by the Court on May 11, 2026, I did, on June 3, 2026, cause the Oil and Gas Leases, and the wells, fixtures, equipment and other personal property located thereon or used or obtained in connection therewith as hereinafter described, to be sold according to law to Rick Elliott and Britt Dowd for the sum of \$520,000.00, being the highest and best bid made therefor;

WHEREAS, return was duly made thereon by Sheriff's Return filed June 3, 2026 and said sale was properly confirmed as more fully set forth in Order Confirming Sheriff's Sale filed by the Court on June 9, 2026 in Case No. MI-2025-CV-000180, without right of redemption as provided by K.S.A. 55-210 and K.S.A. 60-2414(a), and I was directed to make and deliver to Rick Elliott and Britt Dowd, or their assigns, a good and sufficient assignment and conveyance of said oil and gas lease rights and the wells, fixtures, equipment and other personal property thereon or used or obtained in connection therewith; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to K.S.A. 55-210 and K.S.A. 60-2414(a), the right of redemption does not apply to the oil and gas leaseholds being conveyed hereby, and Rick Elliott and Britt

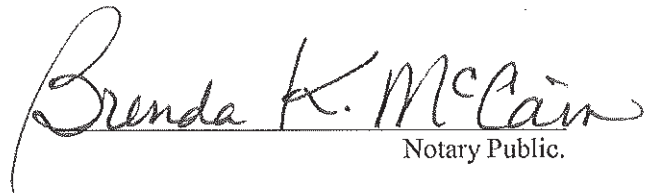
