Dear Sir:-

With further reference to Ohio Oil Co's well on #2 Minor in 9-29-4, please note revised figures after a careful steel line measurement was made. Top of gas sand 1771 to 1777; break of slate 1777 to 1783; oil sand 1783 to 1798. They quit drilling at 1798 with a small amount of water showing in bottom, but it is not considered sufficient to bother. The well filled two 250 tanks, flowing by heads, in 36 hours, and is now capped in waiting on erection of two 1600 tanks.

This oil is to be pumped through three inch line to the company's storage tanks at Gordon, and pursuant to our conversation, if it is convenient for Mr. Cardiff to obtain the production of this well from the office at Gordon, I will turn a completion in on it.
