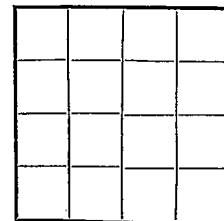

The top of the Ordovician is determined at 3395.

From this depth to 3554 was largely siliceous lime.

From 3554 to 3599 was a white sandstone.

From 3599 to 3610 was a sandstone with lime.

From 3610 to 3617 a pink quartzitic material was found containing abundant weathered feldspar which is either granite or schist. The color was light pink to red, which may indicate that it is granite or slightly weathered arkose overlying unweathered granite.
