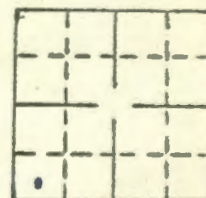

The AAPG's Committee on Statistics of Drilling (CSD) on January 1, 1966 began compiling data on wells reported drilled in the
 U. S., Canada, and Mexico. The Oil and Gas Journal has contracted to publish weekly statistical summaries of the data. These
 will be used by the International Oil Scouts Assoc. American Petroleum Inst., U. S. Bureau of Mines, and other groups, and
 will be considered the official source of drilling information by the U. S. Department of the Interior.

Many of the wells drilled in southeastern Kansas are not presently scouted. Because of this the CSD District 12 Chairman is
 sending this Well Completion Report form to all operators who have stated their intent to drill a well. The information
 received will also be placed on open file in the Oil and Gas Division offices of the State Geological Survey of Kansas. The
 cooperation of all of the operators in returning the completed form will be greatly appreciated.
