The following are the results of tests run on the Rotary core sample taken from the Buckley Lease, Well No. 1, located in the NE SE NW of Section 15, T-25S, R-8E, Greenwood County, Kansas and submitted to our laboratory on December 10, 1966.

This core is Bartlesville formation, brown shaly sandstone. The core is from a virgin territory and was sampled and sealed in a can by a representative of Oilfield Research Laboratories.

The flood-pot tests showed the sand to be Impermeable to water.
