Work Over Operations and Remarks:

October 27, 1956- 4 7/8 inch casing was leaking. Moved company rig over well and cleaned out to 757.5 Ran 3/4" pipe down the outside of the 4 7/8" pipe to a depth of 582 ft. Ran 128 sacks of cement through the 3/4" and then pulled the 3/4" pipe. 4 7/8" is now cemented from bottom to top.

October 29, 1956- Ran bailer in casing and found bottom to be 754.5 ft. Cement job O.K.

Nov. 6, 1956- Consolidated spotted 20 sacks of cement on the bottom through 1" pipe. Tried to squeeze off but was not able to do so. Raised pipe (1") to 744ft. then washed and reversed out excess cement. Ran steel line measure and found total depth to be 746.0 after cement had set up.
