Gentlemen:

Enclosed is my geological report on the Morco well. The well ran flat with the old Cox well one location south and one west down to the Simpson which was four feet higher. It was thirty feet higher than the dry hole to the east in Section 33.

We had shows of oil in the Simpson Sand, but the drill stem test did not recover any fluid, indicating a lack of permeability. The electric log confirmed that the Simpson was impermeable with low porosity near the top and water bearing below.

The Kansas City zone showed a total of eight feet near the top (2344 to 2350 on the log) which will be productive. However, it will be small if productive and make some water according to the test.

The Stalnaker Sand had a good show of gas and some water. At present there is no market.

It was decided by the operator to plug the well and wait for development rather than complete in the Kansas City.
