Dear Sir;

Enclosed is my geological log on this well. Plotted on the log are all formation tops, porous zones, and shows of oil and gas. To summarize:

Kansas City - top zone carried no oil show and very little porosity in samples.


- 2312' - 2314' - very fine porosity and show of oil, not worth testing.

Bartlesville - 2721' - 2726' - fine sand "gas sand" with good porosity and oil and gas show.

- 2727' - 2768' - sand, medium grain, porous with good oil and gas shows.

I recommend that you perforate 2722'-2726' and as much of the sand beginning at 2727' as necessary for production. No other shows of oil and/or gas were found.
