Gentlemen:


Enclosed is my geological log on the Born "B" No. 2. You will note that the log shows a total of 50 feet of Cleveland Sand. This is 10 to 30' thicker than any of your other wells. It was just about flat with your No. 1 Born "B". Shows of oil and gas were found throughout the sand except for the bottom 10 or 12 feet.

Note that sands for possibly disposal or water supply are as follows:

Stalnaker: 1892' to 1947'. Layton: 2226' to 2260' ; 2287' to 2338' ; 2372' to 2425'.

Casing was run to produce the Cleveland Sand found from 2562' to 2612'.
