Gentlemen:

Enclosed you will find my geological log consisting of a sample analysis of the Tatan Limestone and Stalnaker Sand (upper lens).

According to my interpretation of the samples the top of the Stalnaker was found at 1787'. The sand is a fine grained, white, porous sand. There was free oil, odor, and fluorescence in the wet samples and an even light brown stain in the dry ones.

Below that there was some hard, tight, non-porous sand and some more porous sand with the same type of show and staining described above. Total depth was at 1796, 9 feet below the top of the sand.

Casing was run at about 1797 to test this sand. My evaluation is that the sand and the oil show is about the same as No. 1. There may not be as much gas.
