Pennsylvanian conglomerate 3314'-3322'

3314-3321 Limestone with included sand grains grading
downward into

3321-3322 Conglomerate of fresh white cherts, Cotter
types. Marine conglomerate.

Arbuckle Top 3322' Penetration 24' Subsea -1452'

3322-3346 Dolomite, white, coarsely crystalline. Post
Boyce, probably high in Post Boyce.

Remarks: Test abandoned as non-profitable after making more water
than oil on swabbing tests.

Conselman, Letter, # 24, 1941, interpreted the Arbuckle
section as Cotter from 3322'-3332' and Pre Cotter below.
