Duwe and Brouk #1 Lebsack,
SE SE NE, 13-16S-16W,
Elevation 1904' ^{DF}_{LS} (Printed)

Pennsylvanian conglomerate 3430-3491'

3430-3455 Sand interbedded with and included in clay shales,
limes, and nodular limes. Percentage of sand
is small. Thin conglomerate of stained chert
and coarse sand at base.

3455-3491 Probably Arbuckle residuum in place. Cherts and
mottled red and white clay. Sand rare. Most
of chert is of lower Cotter type.

Arbuckle Top 3491' Penetration 21' Sub-sea, minus 1587'
3491-3512 Cotter dolomite.

This is probably very old Cotter, not far above the top of the
Pre-Cotter. Cavings make the sequence too poor for exact correlation.
