GEOLOGICAL REPORT

G. N. RUPE - #2 KROBOTH

Center NW/4 of Section 16-16S-7W, Ellsworth County, Kansas

GEOLOGY

The #2 Kroboth is a West offset to the Rupe #1 Vondra C NE/4 of Section 16, which was completed for 2.8 million cubic feet of Gas in Grand Haven Sand and 300 MCF of Gas from Towanda Limestone. It is located on a small structure along the huge Ellsworth Anticline. A structure Map contoured on the Grand Haven Limestone has been furnished for this report.

CONCLUSIONS:

That the proposed test is situated on a high area where porous Grand Haven Sand and Towanda Limestone are present. That the #2 Kroboth is a development Well in the Kanak Gas Pool.

RECOMMENDATION:

That a development Well be drilled in the C-NW of Section 16-T16S-R7W, Ellsworth County, Kansas, & if the #2 Kroboth is structurally high to the #1 Kanak at the Grand Haven level, that the test be drilled to approximately 2600' to test the Lansing.
