Pennsylvanian conglomerate 3498-3508'?

3498-3503 Sand and chert included with clay shale and nodular limestone.

3503-3508 Sand, medium to coarse; with chert. Probably some clay shale.

Well began to make gas at 3508' and no regular samples were obtainable from 3508-3540'

One sample, caught in a sack over the outlet of a flow line, shows fine rounded sand which may be Arbuckle.

Questionable Arbuckle sand at 3537'. Conglomerate base unknown.

Map as questionable Pre-Cotter sand.
