3525-3530 Clay, sand, and chert. Bright red and yellow sandy clays and buff quartzose oolitic cherts in part showing red clay contacts. Probably residuum. Top from Buehler's letter #42, 1942.

Arbuckle Top 3530' Penetration 15'

Subsea -1445'

3530-3545 Dolomite and quartzose chert. Dolomites are fine to dense, oxidized bright red and yellow. Some buff to white coarsely crystalline dolomite. Fresh buff quartzose cherts with some oolites. Lower Cotter.

Remarks: Test made a 426 barrel well from the Lansing.
