ORDER

Now, the above-captioned matter comes on for consideration and determination by the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas.

An application was filed on July 10, 1990, by Mobil Oil Corporation, for the assignment of an allowable to its M.L. Reynolds "B" Unit Well #8, in the Panoma Council Grove Gas Field in Stevens County, Kansas. Notice was published at least fifteen (15) days prior to the granting of this application in the Wichita Eagle newspaper and in the Hugoton Hermes newspaper, stating that this matter would be granted without a hearing if no protests were received within fifteen (15) days from publication.

The Commission, after giving consideration to the records and files, makes the following findings and conclusions:

1. The application in this docket was filed pursuant to the rules and regulations of the State Corporation Commission and the Kansas Statutes, thus fulfilling both the regulatory and statutory requirements.

2. Notice was proper in every respect and was published as prescribed by the Commission's rules and regulations; notice was furnished at least fifteen (15) days prior to the granting of the application to all interested parties; there were no protests.

3. The applicant's M. L. Reynolds "B" Unit Well #8 is located as follows:

1980 feet from the South line and 1040 feet
from the West line of Section 22, Township 31
South, Range 35 West, Stevens County, Kansas.

The subject well is productive from the Panoma Council Grove Gas Field and the acreage to be attributed is described as follows:

All of Section 22, Township 31 South, Range 35
West, Stevens County, Kansas.

4. The gas produced from said well will be sold on the spot market at a price to be determined; that utilization of the gas from said well heretofore described is for a purpose permitted by the laws of Kansas, and the rules and regulations of the Commission, and will not constitute waste or violate correlative rights.

5. The application should be granted in accordance with the above findings.

IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED: That the application of Mobil Oil Corporation for the assignment of an allowable for its M. L. Reynolds "B" Unit Well #8, be, and the same is hereby granted, and that the acreage set forth above be attributed to said well.

IT IS FURTHER BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED: That (1) upon the completion of the M. L. Reynolds "B" Unit Well #8 well, as described in Finding (3) of this Order, as a commercially producing gas well and pursuant to the rules and regulations of the Commission and the Basic Proration Order for the Panoma Council Grove Gas Field, and (2) the filing of an acreage and attribution certificate with the Conservation Division, 200 Colorado Derby Building, 202 West First Street, Wichita, Kansas, an appropriate gas allowable be assigned thereto.

Any party affected by this Order may apply, by written petition, for a hearing thereon before the Commission, pursuant to K.S.A. 77-537. Such petition must be filed with the Director of the Conservation Division, 202 West First Street, Suite #200, Wichita, Kansas 67202, within three (3) days following service of this Order. If a hearing is not requested, this Order shall become effective upon the expiration of the three (3) day time period for requesting a hearing.

The allowable shall be assigned to said well upon the effective date of this Order, or upon the date of the beginning of the deliverability test, or upon the date of the filing of the certificate of the acreage plat, whichever date is later.


The Commission retains jurisdiction of the subject matter and the parties for the purpose of entering such further Order or Orders as from time to time it may deem proper.


