Lower "L" sand 4930-58

DST recovered 60' HOCM & 90' oil; BHP 454.
The DST indicates that heavy stimulation may
be required to bring this zone in. If the
Production Department believes the zone can
be completed without damaging the upper zone,
then now would be the best time to complete.

"L" sand 4890-96

DST 4870-4905 flowed oil with very little gas.
If early testing of this zone indicates that
heavy stimulation is necessary, it would be
better to perforate additionally in the inter-
val 4876-88, as much as or little as is required.
