3755-3760 Red clay shale, pink nodular lime with included
sand grains and rare algal lime with included
sand grains.

Arbuckle Top 3760' Penetration 42' Sub-sea, minus 1540'
3760-3770 Dolomite, coarse, white and pink.
3770-3785 Dolomite, fine to medium, white and pink.
3785-3802 Dolomite, medium, pink and light brown.

This section is believed to be Pre-Cotter. It fits best into
the Pre-Boyce, the interval between the Boyce sand and the Weigel
cherty dolomite. This correlation is questionable and subject
to change. Pre-Cambrian estimated to be not lower than 3920'.
