3375-3388 Red loose medium sand grains, red sandy shale, and
quartzose oolitic chert.

Arbuckle top 3388 feet - penetration 49 feet (datum -1427 feet)

Pre-Cotter

3388-3437 Dolomite, medium porosity, with some staining in
the upper part. Most of the dolomite has FeS₂
specks.--Pre-Boyce (?)

Remarks:

This Arbuckle section is tentatively called pre-Boyce. However, it could
be as young as post-Boyce. Toward the northwest this FeS₂ referred to
above is rather a good marker of the pre-Boyce. Abandoned as dry.

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
