PAINÉ DRILLING COMPANY HAS PUT ITS #1 WORCESTER, NE NW NW, 23-7-22W IN GRAHAM COUNTY ON THE PUMP. THE WELL REVIVES THE WORCESTER POOL. ROGER WELTY CALLED THE LANSING AT 3475 (-1231' KB). AFTER PERFORATING 3643-45 AND TREATING WITH ACID, OPERATOR SWAB TESTED EIGHT BARRELS OIL PER HOUR FOR FIVE HOURS. OTHER MARKERS CALLED FROM THE 2244 FOOT KELLY BUSHING ELEVATION ARE: ANHYDRITE 1843, TOPEKA 3182, HEEBNER 3435, TORONTO 3461, BASE KANSAS CITY 3671, CONGLOMERATE 3769 AND REWORKED ARBUCKLE 3780 FEET. COMPANY TOOLS CUT THE WELL WHICH IS SEVEN AND A HALF MILES NORTHEAST OF HILL CITY, KANSAS.
