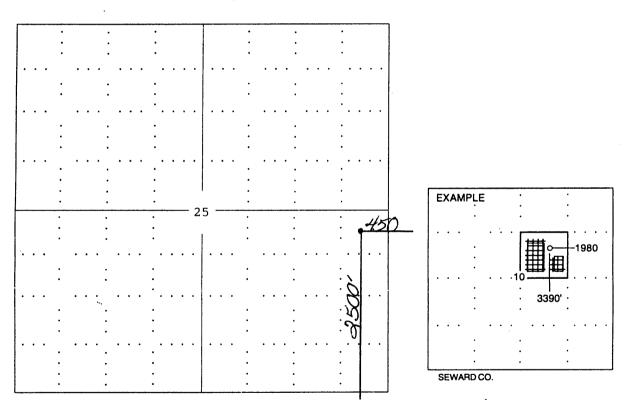

The free fluids must be removed from the reserve pit as soon as practical after drilling operations have ceased. **Please keep all pits away from any draws**.

If production casing is set all completion fluids shall be removed on a daily basis.

The fluids should be taken to an authorized disposal well. Please call the District Office at (785) 625-0550 when the fluids have been removed. Also, please file the enclosed CDP-5 form, Surface Pond Waste Transfer, within 30 days of fluid removal.
