Dear Elizabeth Lyon,

The above described well under your operation has been abandoned and unplugged longer than 90 days. There is no current record at the Conservation Division that temporary abandonment status has been requested or that the well has been plugged.

Current Commission Regulation 82-3-111 states that an operator must either 1) return the well to service, 2) plug the well or, 3) give notice of the temporary abandonment on the prescribed application forms to the Division within 90 days after operations have ceased on the well.

This letter serves as notice that the above described well must be plugged immediately or classified as a temporary abandoned well by filing a CP-111 form with the Conservation Division. If no action is taken within 60 days from the date of this letter, this matter will be turned over to the legal department. You will then be subject to a \$100 penalty and possible license suspension until you have complied with the regulation. 

The Conservation Division's review of form CP-1, either in the central or district office, does not include an inquiry into well ownership or the filing operator's legal right to plug the well.

**This notice in no way constitutes authorization to plug the above-captioned well by persons not having legal rights of ownership or interest in the well. This notice is void after ninety (90) days from the above date.**
