PARRY SAND

193<sup>2</sup>-58'. Sand, grey, angular, micaceous, medium grain, with good to fair granular porosity and strong odor, rich fluorescence and shows of free gassy oil. Zone appears to carry commercial oil, but should be tested in top 10', to lessen water problems.

LAYTON SAND

2185-94'. Sand, grey, angular, medium, with fair granular porosity, good odor. Light even staining and rich fluorescence. Zone should produce commercial oil.

It was recommended that 5½ be set and cemented @2186' (8' off bottom) to test the Stalnaker, Parry, and Layton Sands.

The Conservation Division's review of form CP-1, either in the central or district office, does not include an inquiry into well ownership or the filing operator's legal right to plug the well.
