The Stamper "A" #1 was plugged in the following manner:

The Dakota water broke in at a depth of 750 to 755'. We immediately pulled tubing and rods and squeezed the hole in the casing at 750 to 755' with 350 sacks cement. Cement circulated to surface between the 5-1/2" production casing and the 8-5/8" surface casing. We drilled out cement and at 759' we started drilling on casing. We went in hole with a milling shoe and milled from 759 to 764' and in shale and cement from 764 to 775'. Came out of hole with wash pipe and milling shoe. Went in hole with bit and drilled down and concluded we were outside the 5-1/2" production casing and, in fact, the production casing had parted at approximately 755' and had kicked over in the hole.

Dennis Hammel, Plainville,Ks We continued down the side of the casing to 1020' and called State Plugger/ and received plugging instructions. There was good circulation and we mixed 25 sacks of cement and filled the drill pipe. Pulled up one joint and again refilled the casing with cement and attempted to pull out another joint of casing. At that point the pipe stuck in the hole. We ran a Dia-Log free-point and backed off pipe at 759'. We left 5 drill collars and 1 joint of tubing in the hole. We then came out of hole and went back in and set a packer at 606' and cemented with 200 sacks of cement at 1200#. Then filled 5-1/2" casing with 75 sacks of cement to surface. Job complete.
