
Dear John:

We are attorneys for EOG Resources, Inc. We are filing herewith a Verified Affidavit for Use of Mud as an Alternative to the Cementing Requirement in ¶ 18(D) of the Panoma Council Grove B.P.O. on behalf of EOG Resources, Inc., with respect to the above-referenced well. As we discussed, this well was drilled with the intention of cementing the Council Grove and Chase formations so as to avoid the need for this Verified Affidavit for Use of Mud as an Alternative to the Cementing Requirement in ¶ 18(D) of the Panoma Council Grove B.P.O. However, as we discussed, problems with measurement in the completion of this well occurred, and, consequently, EOG Resources, Inc., cannot meet the cementing requirement of ¶ 18(D) of the Panoma Council Grove B.P.O. EOG Resources, Inc., has contacted Anadarko Petroleum Corporation and has determined that it has no objection to the use of mud as an alternative to the cementing requirement in this particular well, due to the existing circumstances. As we discussed, if no objection is filed within fifteen days of the service of this Affidavit, EOG Resources, Inc., will not have any further requirements with respect to the Verna 11 #3 well as to the cementing requirement of the Panoma Council Grove B.P.O. In the event that a protest is filed within fifteen days of service of this Affidavit, EOG Resources, Inc., will revisit this issue and will inform the Kansas Corporation Commission staff as to how it wishes to proceed with this matter.
