Dear Mr. Corrick:

I have your letter of May 26. I have also found your letter of February 8, which when received in this office was turned over to the Plugging Department for answer, however, it inadvertently got into the files with the plugging report and was never answered, which I very much regret.

This well was drilled in the center of the NW/4 of Section 34-9S-26W, Sheridan County, Kansas, by Roberts and Murray. It was commenced October 24, 1936, and was completed January 20, 1937. It was drilled to a total depth of 4664'.

Mr. Otis A. Roberts, 618 Exchange Building, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, apparently was the principal owner in this well. The last we knew of Mr. Roberts he had moved to Denver but is now somewhere in Wyoming and his address is unknown to this office.

Our records disclose there there was 112' of 15 1/2" casing cemented from top to bottom. This pipe was not pulled as pipe cemented from top to bottom is impossible to pull and the only manner in which pipe could be cut off below plow depth would require a cutting torch to cut it off to the desired depth which usually is about one or one and one-half feet below the surface which would not interfere with plowing of the land.

According to our records this well was plugged with heavy mud from 4664' to a depth of 122' at which point the well was bridged and a 15' cement plug set on bridge and another cement plug set in the top of the surface pipe.

Smith, Quinter, Kansas (to whom I sent a copy of my letter to you) has received no information from your office. I am wondering why you cannot give us the courtesy of a reply in this matter?

Since this land is covered with a wheat crop and since harvest time will soon be here, the owner of the land, Mr. Ziegler, is anxious to know what he can do, if anything, with this pipe. I would suggest that, in view of the circumstances, that you send a man out to Quinter to confer with Mr. N. Smith, who operates a real estate office at Quinter.

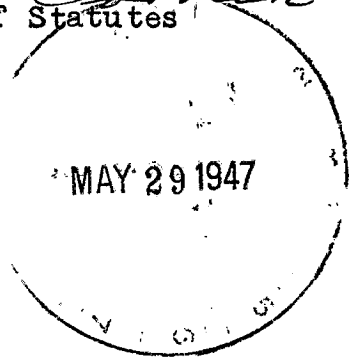
In any event, please let me know what you intend to do in the matter and send a carbon copy of your letter to me to Mr. Smith at Quinter, Kansas.

Dear Mr. Morgan:

I am writing you in regard to an abandoned oil well in Sheridan County, Kansas. I do not know the exact date that this well was abandoned but believe it was after 1935 and before 1939. At the time the well was drilled the land belonged to my father, Mr. E. D. Corrick. In 1943 the land was sold by the heirs to Mr. John Ziegler of Collyer, Kansas.

When the well was abandoned the pipe was left standing, and Mr. Ziegler says it is in the way and wants to know if it will be all right for him to remove it without violating any state laws or regulations. I talked with Mr. Clevenger, attorney for the State Corporation Commission, and he advised me to write you. He thought there should have been an affidavit filed setting forth in detail the method used in plugging the well before it was abandoned. The description of the land is as follows:

NW 1/4 34-9-26 in Sheridan County, Kansas

I do not know the name of the people who drilled the well but know they were from Oklahoma.

Any advice you may be able to give me will be greatly appreciated.
