This is an old well bore that we were unaware. We do not have any information on this well

cement crew rigged up on location to do a 1" fill up. on an old abandoned well that Quest had uncovered while diggin a earth pit to drill the SWD well. The old abandon well had 6" casing & 2-7/8" tubing inside. Cement was up the backside

of the 2-7/8". Keypley had ran the first joint of 1" and only got down 16' and hit solid material. Started washing through the 1" and the only thing that we could get up was pecies of ge and cement. After talking on location with Clayton & Allen

with the KCC it was decided by them that the well had in fact been plugged. They had instructed us to fill the remaining 16' w/ cement. Then cut it off 3' below surface. Used 2sks cement, well plugged

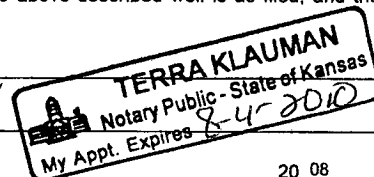
