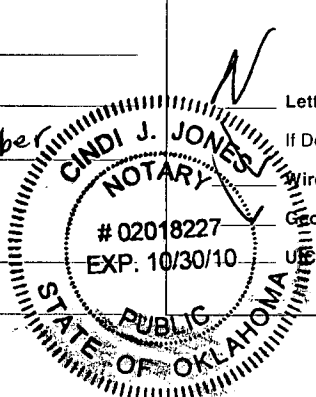

GEOLOGICAL REPORT RODNEY 13-5 C SW NW SECTION 13 – T33S – R17W COMANCHE COUNTY, KANSAS

SUMMARY

The above captioned well was drilled to a total depth of 5,250 feet on April 24, 2008. A one-man logging unit was on location from approximately 2,800 feet to TD. The well was under the geological supervision of the undersigned from 4,000 feet to TD. At TD, Weatherford electric logs were run that consisted of Dual Induction, Compensated Neutron-Density and Micro-log. From the data collected while drilling and analyzing, potential hydrocarbon shows were encountered in the Marmaton-aged Pawnee Limestone and the Mississippian Warsaw Dolomite. The decision was made to set production casing and complete the well in the Upper and Lower Warsaw zones. However, the Pawnee interval should be perforated before plugging the well.

PAWNEE LIMESTONE

The Pawnee Limestone was cut at 4,947 (-3053) feet. The electric logs indicated a five foot productive zone with cross-plotting porosity as high as 10%. There was also a 45 unit gas kick. Samples were describe as off white, tan, gray, buff to dark brown, slightly shaley, argillaceous limestone with very fine to fine microcrystalline, slightly dense porosity with some pin-point porosity being observed. A dull yellow fluorescence could be seen.

WARSAW DOLOMITE

The top of the Warsaw Dolomite was encountered at 5,046 (-3,152) feet with the logs indicating an upper and lower potentially productive zone. The samples in the upper zone were described as white, off-white, to cream, very soft friable, limey in part, calcareous dolomite with a very fine to fine sucrosic texture. Good inter-crystalline and pin-point porosity with a trace of vugular porosity were seen. An abundant bright yellow fluorescence with live light brown oil stain, excellent streaming cut and good odor was observed. The gas chromatograph recorded several kicks through out, with the largest being 147 units. The electric logs indicated a productive zone of 56 feet with an average porosity over 12% and two intervals in excess of 20%.

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WICHITA, KS

The lower Warsaw zone was encountered at 5,120 (-3,226), with samples being described as off-white, tan to brown, very fine to fine, calcareous in part, slightly limey dolomite with some off white fresh chert. Good pin-point porosity could be seen. Bright yellow fluorescence with some brown live oil stain was observed, along with a good streaming cut and good strong odor. The gas chromatograph recorded gas kicks of 143 and 146 units. A 42 foot zone was shown on the electric logs with an average porosity of 15%.

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
CONCLUSION

A decision was made to run pipe and attempt completion in both intervals. However, logs indicated that the Pawnee Limestone could also be productive and should be perforated before plugging of the well.

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

DEFINITIONS: In these terms and conditions, "ALLIED" shall mean Allied Cementing Co., LLC, and "CUSTOMER" shall refer to the party identified by that term on the front of this contract. As applicable, "Job" relates to the services described on the front side of this contract, "Merchandise" refers to the material described on the front of this contract and to any other materials, products, or supplies used, sold, or furnished under the requirements of this contract.

—**TERMS:** Unless satisfactory credit has been established, CUSTOMER must tender full cash payment to ALLIED before the job is undertaken or merchandise is delivered. If satisfactory credit has been established, the terms of payment for the job and/or merchandise, including bulk cement, are net cash, payable in 30 days from the completion of the job and/or delivery of the merchandise. For all past due invoices, CUSTOMER agrees to pay interest on amounts invoiced at a rate of 18 percent per annum until paid. Notwithstanding the foregoing, in no event shall this Contract provide for interest exceeding the maximum rate of interest that CUSTOMER may agree to pay under applicable law. If any such interest should be provided for, it shall be and hereby is deemed to be a mistake, and this contract shall be automatically reformed to lower the rate of interest to the maximum legal contract rate; any amounts previously paid as excess interest shall be deducted from the amounts owing from the CUSTOMER or at the option of ALLIED, refunded directly to CUSTOMER. For purposes of this paragraph, ALLIED and CUSTOMER agree that Kansas law shall apply. Any discounts granted with this contract are null and void if the charges are not paid when due.

—**ATTORNEY FEES:** In any legal action or proceeding between the parties to enforce any of the terms of this Service Contract, or in any way pertaining to the terms of this Contract, the prevailing party shall be entitled to recover all expenses, including, but not limited to, a reasonable sum as and for attorney's fees.

—**PRICES AND TAXES:** All merchandise listed in ALLIED'S current price schedule are F.O.B. ALLIED'S local station and are subject to change without notice. All prices are exclusive of any federal, state, local, or special taxes for the sale or use of the merchandise or services listed. The amount of taxes required to be paid by ALLIED shall be added to the quoted prices charged to CUSTOMER.

—**TOWING CHARGES:** ALLIED will make a reasonable attempt to get to and from each job site using its own equipment. Should ALLIED be unable to do so because of poor or inadequate road conditions, and should it become necessary to employ a tractor or other pulling equipment to get to or from the job site, the tractor or pulling equipment will be supplied by CUSTOMER or, if furnished by ALLIED, will be charged to and paid by CUSTOMER.

—**PREPARATION CHARGES:** If a job and/or merchandise is ordered and CUSTOMER cancels the order after preparation of a chemical solution or other material, CUSTOMER will pay ALLIED for the expenses incurred by ALLIED as a result of the cancellation.

—**DEADHAUL CHARGES:** Unless otherwise specified on the front of this Contract, a deadhaul charge as set forth in ALLIED'S current price book will be charged each way for each service unit which is ordered by CUSTOMER but not used.

—**SERVICE CONDITIONS AND LIABILITIES:**

1. ALLIED carries public liability and property damage insurance, but since there are so many uncertain and unknown conditions beyond ALLIED'S control, ALLIED shall not be liable for injuries to property or persons or for loss or damage arising from the performance of the job or delivery of the merchandise. CUSTOMER shall be responsible for and indemnify, defend, and hold harmless ALLIED, its officers, agents and employees, from and against any and all claims or suits for:

(A) Damage to property or for bodily injury, sickness, disease, or death, brought by any person, including CUSTOMER and/or the well owner; and:

(B) Oil spills, pollution, surface or sub-surface damage, injury to the well, reservoir loss, or damage arising from a well blowout arising out of or in connection with ALLIED'S performance of the job or furnishing of merchandise in accordance with this contract, unless such loss or damage is caused by the willful misconduct or gross negligence of ALLIED or its employees.

2. With respect to any of ALLIED'S tools, equipment, or instruments which are lost in the well or damaged when performing or attempting to perform the job or, in the case of marine operations, are lost or damaged at any time after delivery to the landing for CUSTOMER and before return to ALLIED at the landing, CUSTOMER shall either recover the lost item without cost to ALLIED or reimburse ALLIED the current replacement cost of the item unless the loss or damage results from the sole negligence of ALLIED or its employees.

3. ALLIED does not assume any liability or responsibility for damages or conditions resulting from chemical action in cements caused by contamination of water or other fluids.

As applicable, "Job" relates to the services described on the front side of this contract, "Merchandise" refers to the material described on the front of this contract and to any other materials, products, or supplies used, sold, or furnished under the requirements of this contract.

—**TERMS:** Unless satisfactory credit has been established, CUSTOMER must tender full cash payment to ALLIED before the job is undertaken or merchandise is delivered. If satisfactory credit has been established, the terms of payment for the job and/or merchandise, including bulk cement, are net cash, payable in 30 days from the completion of the job and/or delivery of the merchandise. For all past due invoices, CUSTOMER agrees to pay interest on amounts invoiced at a rate of 18 percent per annum until paid. Notwithstanding the foregoing, in no event shall this Contract provide for interest exceeding the maximum rate of interest that CUSTOMER may agree to pay under applicable law. If any such interest should be provided for, it shall be and hereby is deemed to be a mistake, and this contract shall be automatically reformed to lower the rate of interest to the maximum legal contract rate; any amounts previously paid as excess interest shall be deducted from the amounts owing from the CUSTOMER or at the option of ALLIED, refunded directly to CUSTOMER. For purposes of this paragraph, ALLIED and CUSTOMER agree that Kansas law shall apply. Any discounts granted with this contract are null and void if the charges are not paid when due.

—**ATTORNEY FEES:** In any legal action or proceeding between the parties to enforce any of the terms of this Service Contract, or in any way pertaining to the terms of this Contract, the prevailing party shall be entitled to recover all expenses, including, but not limited to, a reasonable sum as and for attorney's fees.

—**DEADHAUL CHARGES:** Unless otherwise specified on the front of this Contract, a deadhaul charge as set forth in ALLIED'S current price book will be charged each way for each service unit which is ordered by CUSTOMER but not used.

—**SERVICE CONDITIONS AND LIABILITIES:**

1.
