The above referenced work-over pit was permitted on 6/1/2007. Work-over pits shall be classed within 365 calendar days after work-over operations have commenced. The work-over partial in question must be closed by 5/31/2008. Should an exception be warranted, it must be received by 5/31/2008.

A Closure of Surface Pit, form CDP-4, should be filed within 30 days after the work-over pit are closed. Conservation division forms are available through our office and on the KCC web lite: http://kcc.ks.gov/conservation/forms/. Failure to timely close the pit, file an extension or filethe form within the allotted time periods may be punishable by an administrative penalty.
