A Closure of Surface Pit, form CDP-4, should be filed within 30 days after the work-over pits are closed. Conservation division forms are available through our office and on the KCC web lite: http://kcc.ks.gov/conservation/forms/. Failure to timely close the pit, file an extension or file he form within the allotted time periods may be punishable by an administrative penalty.
