Dear Mr. Callewaert:

This letter is to inform you that you have been granted an extension of time in which to close the drilling pits associated with the drilling of the Robbins 1-19 well.

The original 365 days for closure expired September 20, 2008. This extension will expire September 1, 2009. We urge you to make every effort to close these pits within this time frame. In the event there is water standing in these pits, please dewater and dispose of fluids in an authorized disposal facility to expedite closure. Extension of this time frame automatically extends the time period for filing the Closure of Surface Pit form.

*Failure to close the pit or request an additional extension prior to the expiration date may result in a fine in accordance with K.A.R. 82-3-602(a). An additional extension will only be granted for good cause and after K.C.C. field staff has made an inspection of the site. Should field staff discover that said pit has been closed before the date of extension request, an administrative penalty may be assessed to you through K.C.C. invoice.*

Please accept my apologies for allowing time to close the pit on this hole to expire without closure or an application for another extension of time. The working pits and fresh water pit are mostly closed and the reserve pit has been partially closed but not completely closed yet. There is still some rain water in the pits that needs to dry. The contractor we have hired to do this work, Dennett Plumbing and Excavating closed as much of the pits as possible on March 20, 2009 but was unable to finish because the pits were still too wet to finish at that time. Since that date there has been over 12 inches of rain in this area. A copy of the invoice from the dirt contractor is enclosed. We are making an honest effort to get this work done. The weather isn't cooperating. Would you please give us another 180 day extension of time and we will continue to make every effort to close these pits completely as quickly as possible.
