Dear Ms. Dahlinger:

This letter is to inform you that you have been granted an extension of time in which to close the drilling pits associated with the drilling of the Platt 2-6 well.

The original 365 days for closure expired August 30, 2008. This extension will expire May 19, 2009. We urge you to make every effort to close these pits within this time frame. In the event there is water standing in these pits, please dewater and dispose of fluids in an authorized disposal facility to expedite closure. Extension of this time frame automatically extends the time period for filing the Closure of Surface Pit form.

Failure to close the pit or request an additional extension prior to the expiration date may result in a fine in accordance with K.A.R. 82-3-602(a). An additional extension will only be granted for good cause and after K.C.C. field staff has made an inspection of the site. Should field staff discover that said pit has been closed before the date of extension request, an administrative penalty may be assessed to you through K.C.C. invoice.

Dear Ms. Flaharty:

After speaking to our field personnel, I understand that one drilling pit at the above referenced well site has yet to dry sufficiently to allow for replacement of the excavated soil to restore the ground surface.

The KCC previously granted Hummon Corporation until November 30, 2008, to complete surface restoration for these drilling pits.

I would like to request an additional six month time period to complete surface restoration of the remaining pit. We are entering the winter and spring seasons, which are not usually conducive to evaporation, however, I wanted to get an extension of time request submitted to you before November 30, 2008. If we are able to restore the ground surface sooner, we would of course proceed to file the Form CDP-4 with your office.

Please advise me of the KCC's recommendation for a time frame to complete surface restoration at this well site.

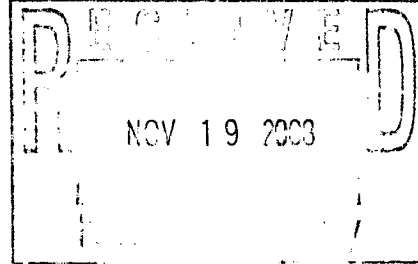
